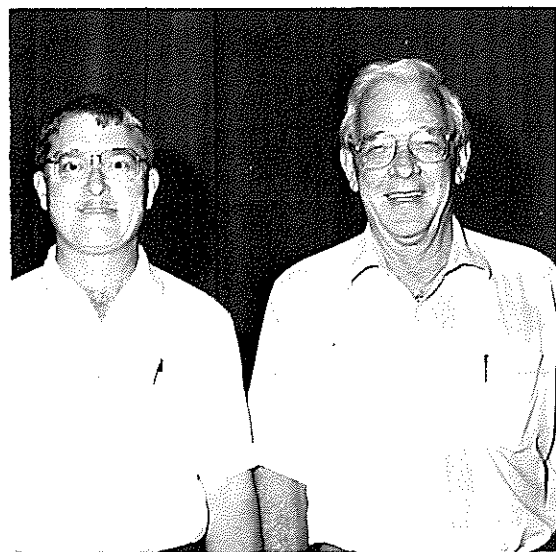


Council Represents Student Body

A new program was introduced in KISD — the Student Advisory Council, (SAC).
