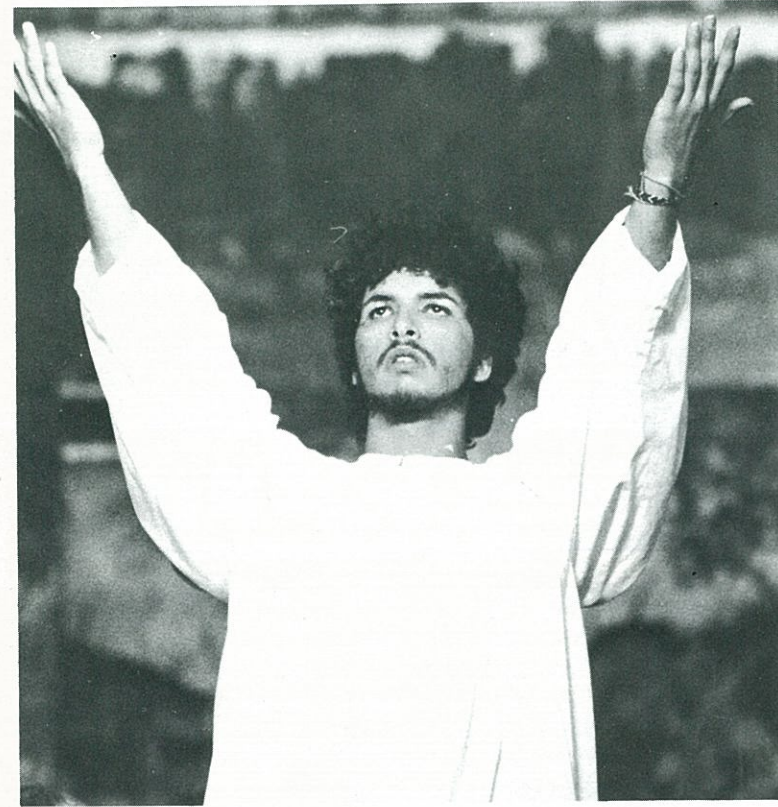


King Without A Crown
