Freshmen DaiAnn & Ronnie


Freshman Favorites for 1987-88 include Ronnie Martinez and DaiAnn Knight.

Ronnie's activities include playing both basketball and baseball and he is a member of the 'K' Band.


He enjoys sports, MTV, and parties.
