"It was good. Angie and I had a great time," said senior Vic Woods.



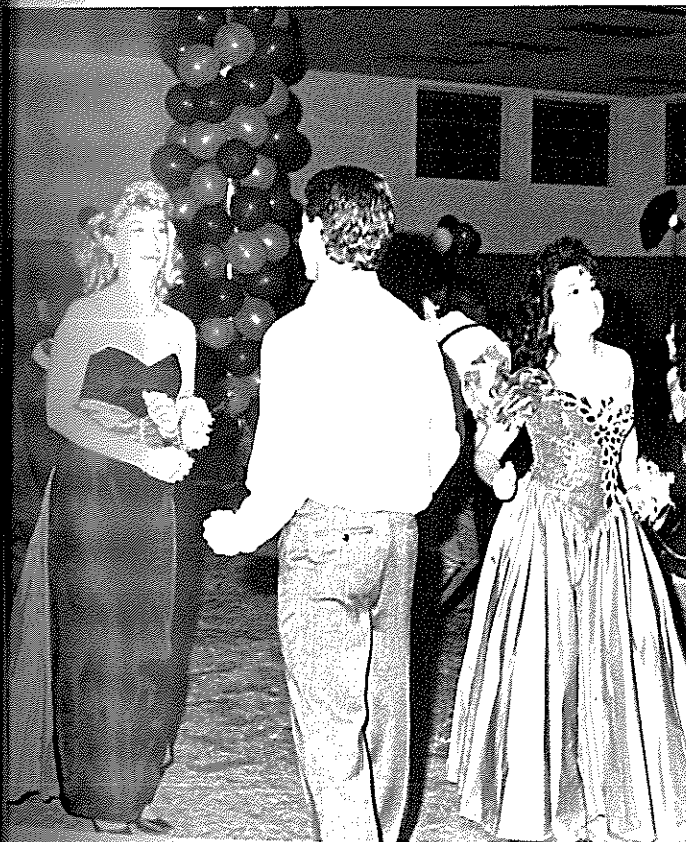

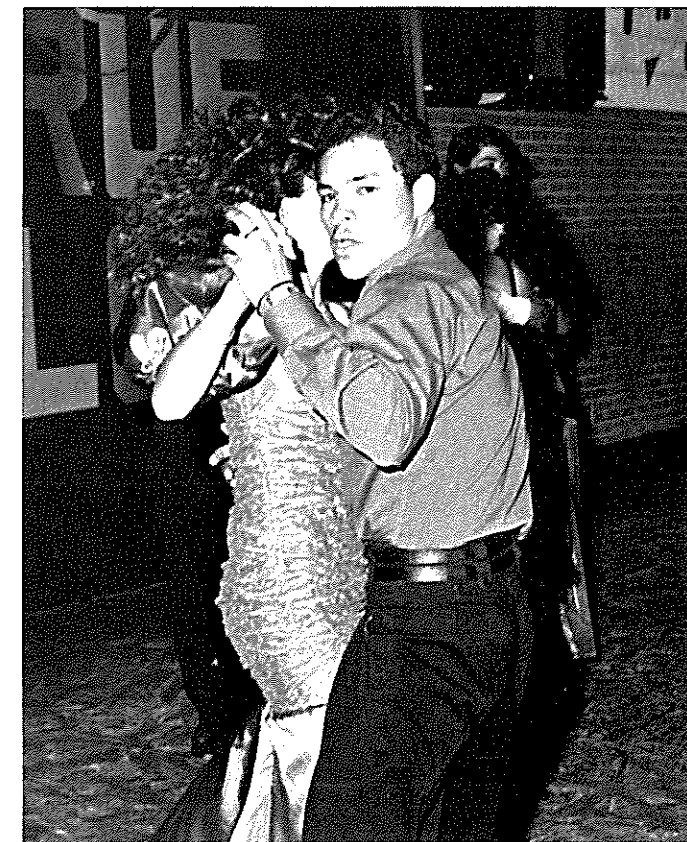
