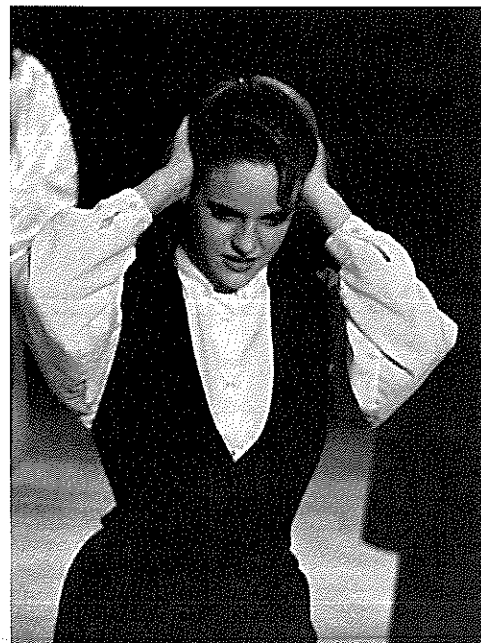


Thespians Present One Act Play

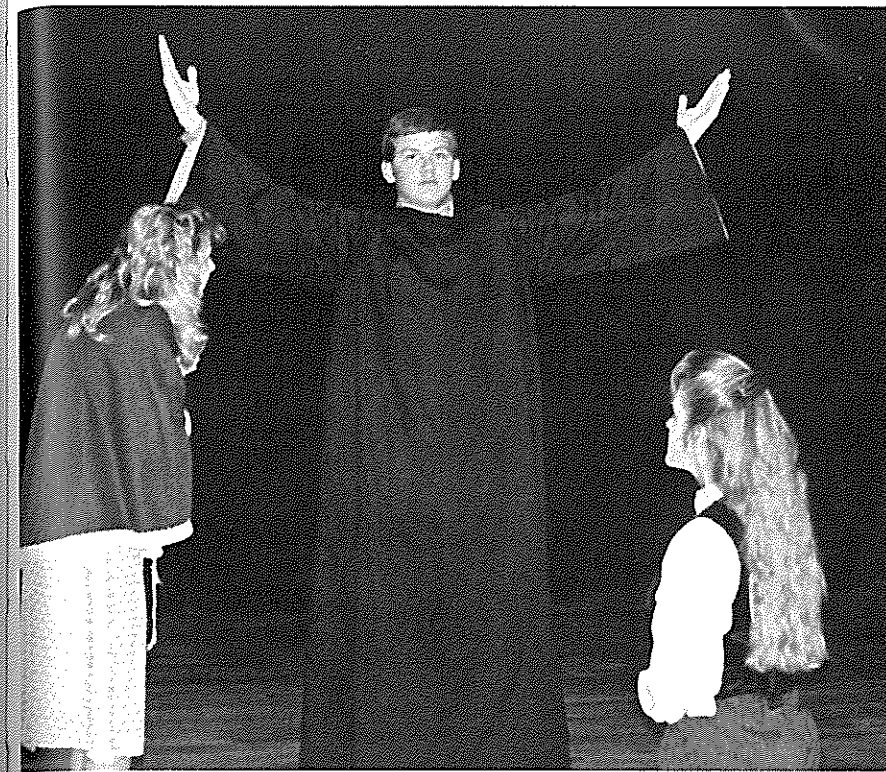
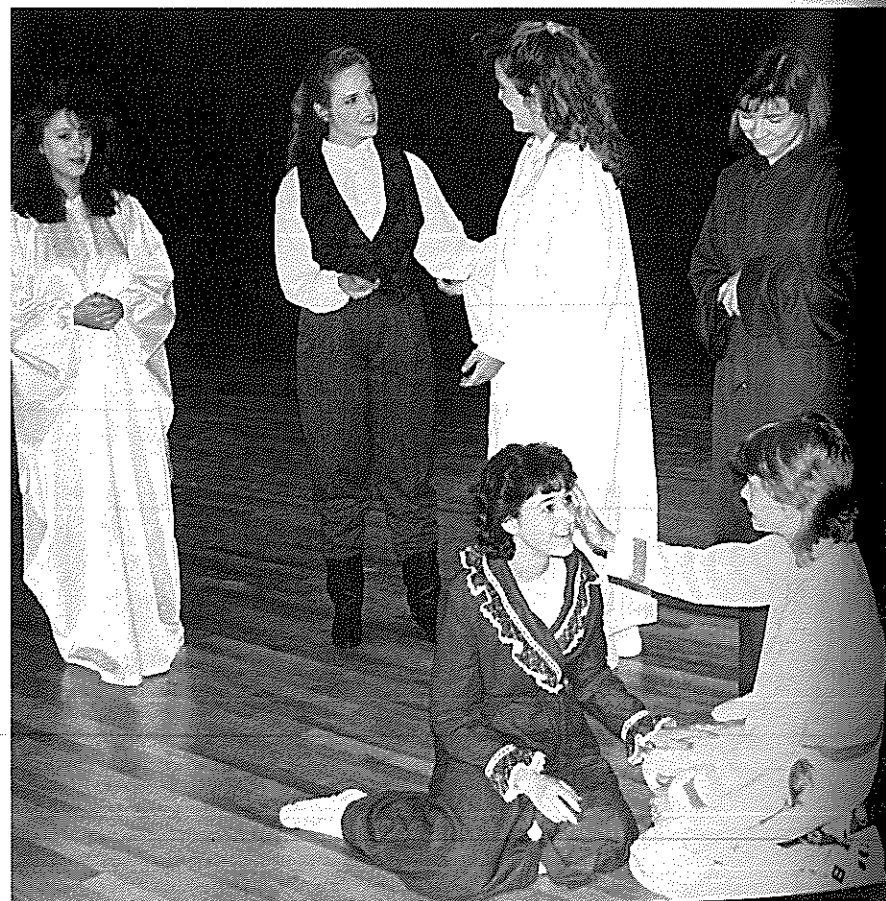
