

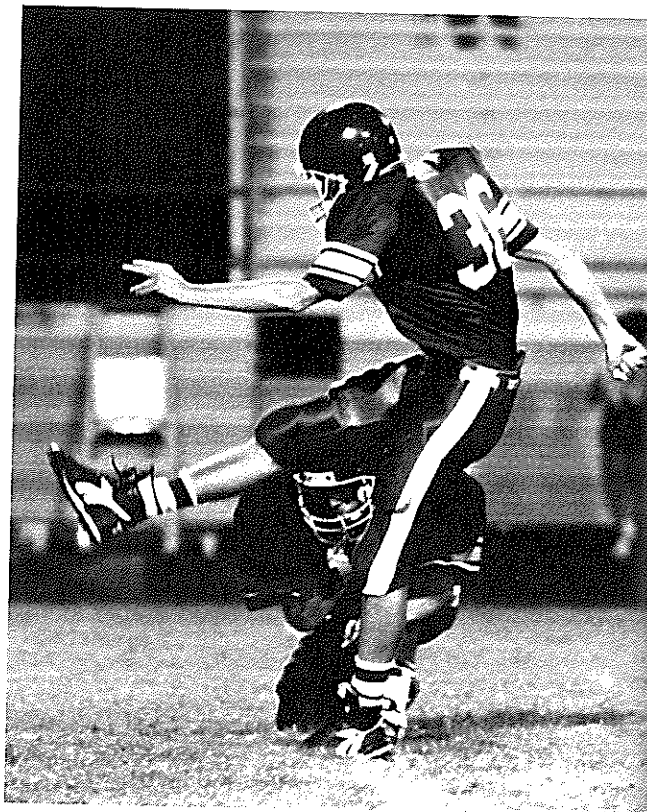
KHS Meets Foreign Lands

Brian Munck was not only the kicker for the KHS football team, he also played varsity basketball.

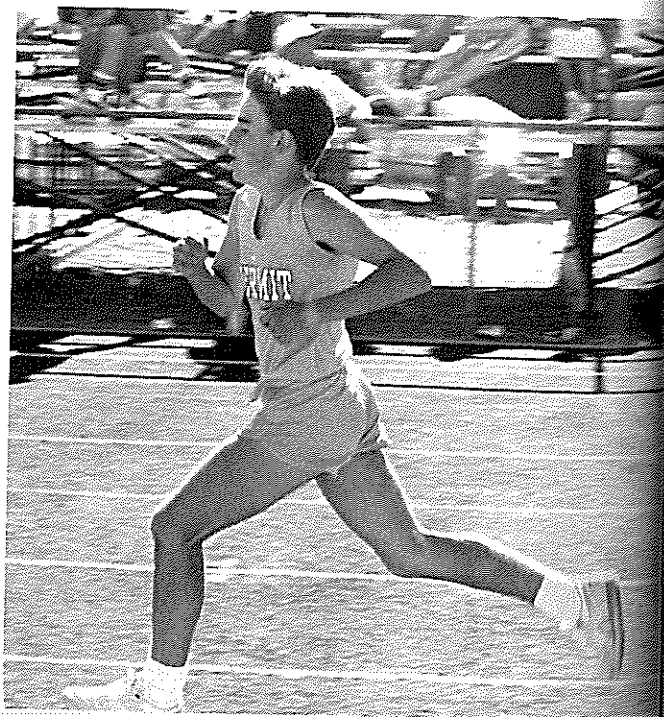
Paul Flexas is 17 yrs. old and comes from Mallorca, Spain.

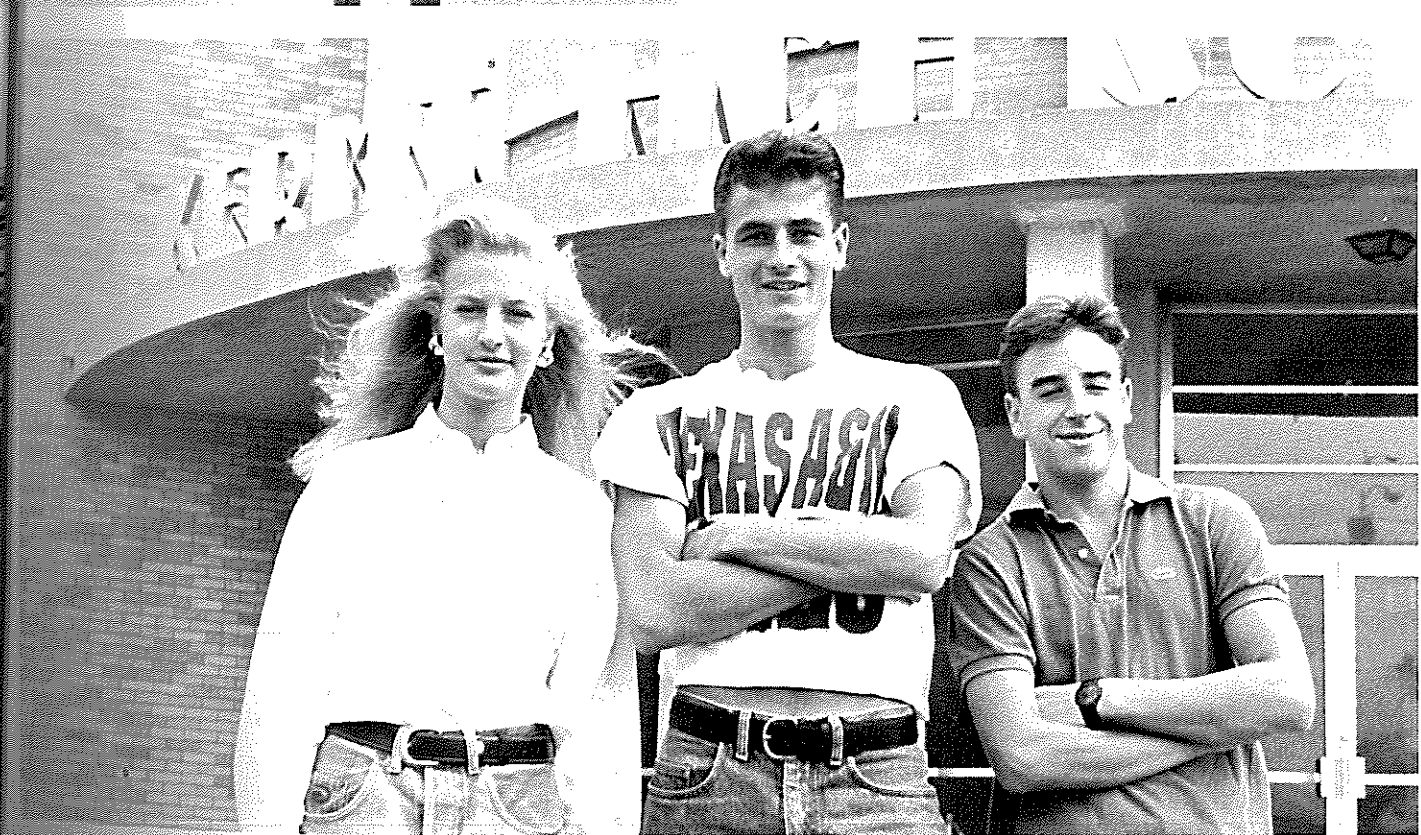
Helga Odendahl is 18 yrs. old and comes from Wuppertall, West Germany.
