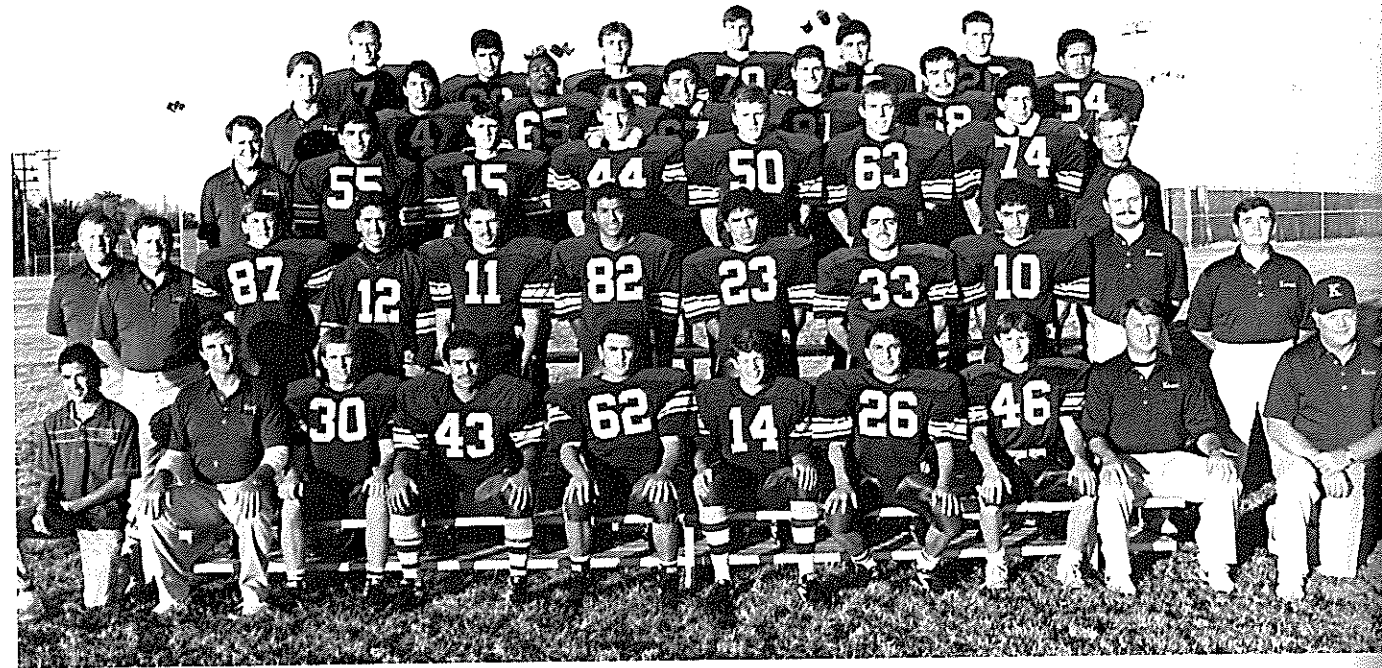


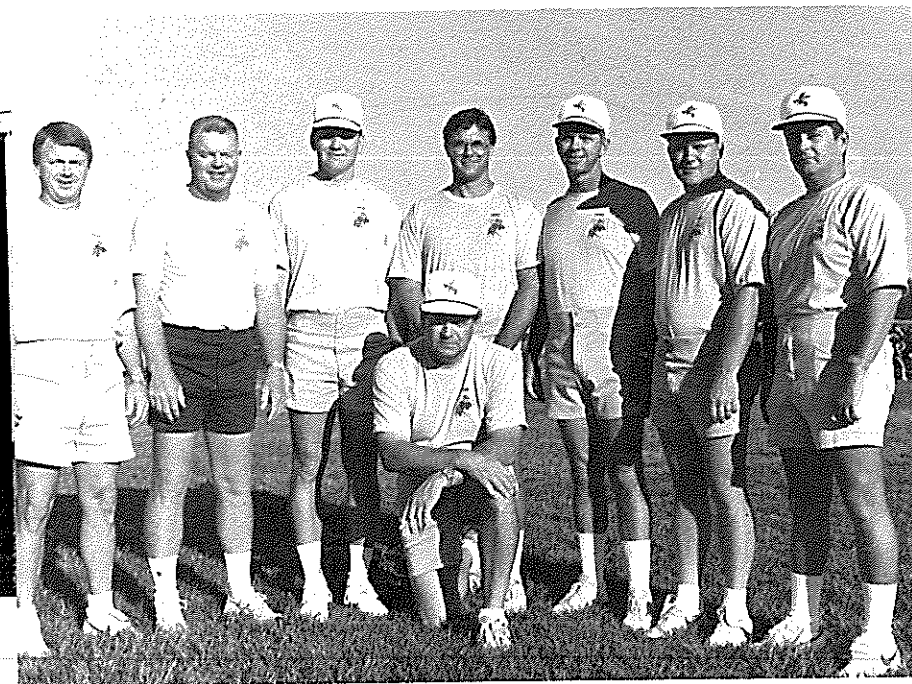
# Jacket Gridiron Squad



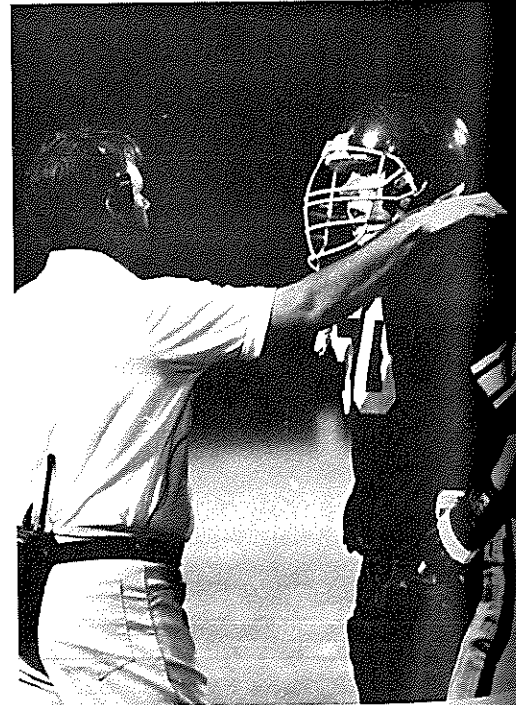

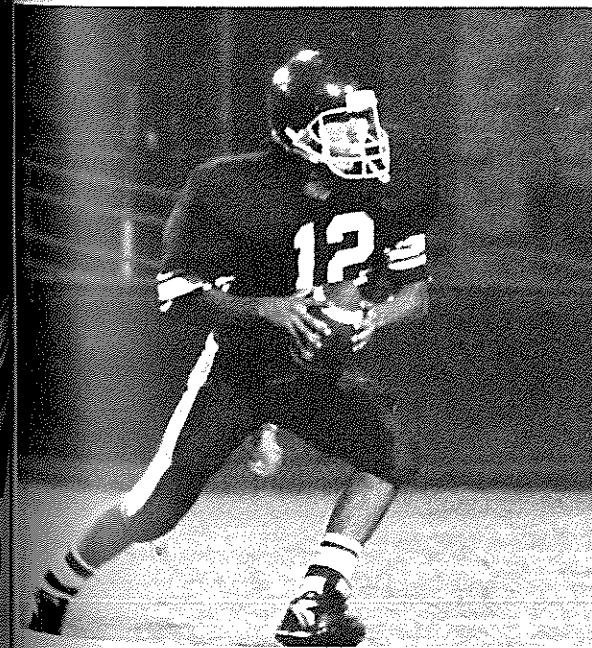
Members of the varsity Yellow Jacket squad stand before the "K" band, displaying emotion at winning their opening game of 1990 against the Seminole Indians.



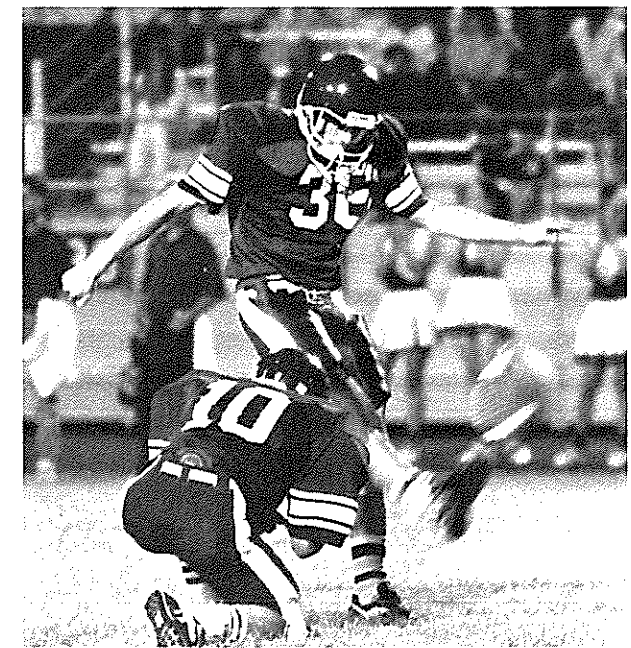
