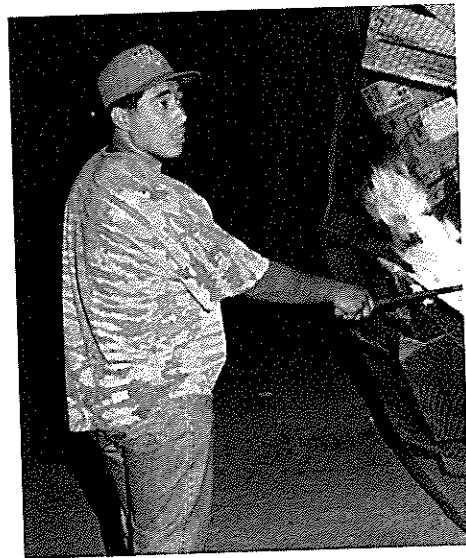


Homecoming Queen: Nikki Riley

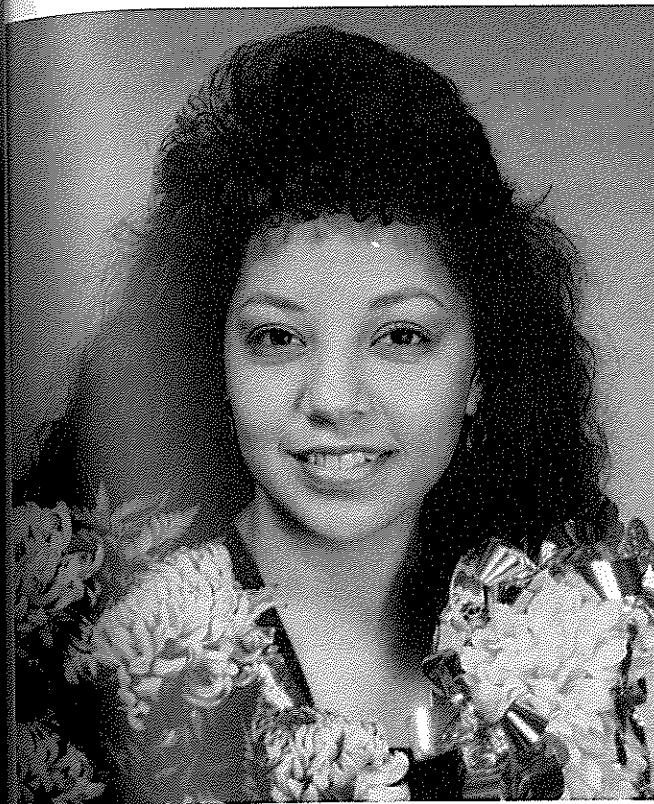

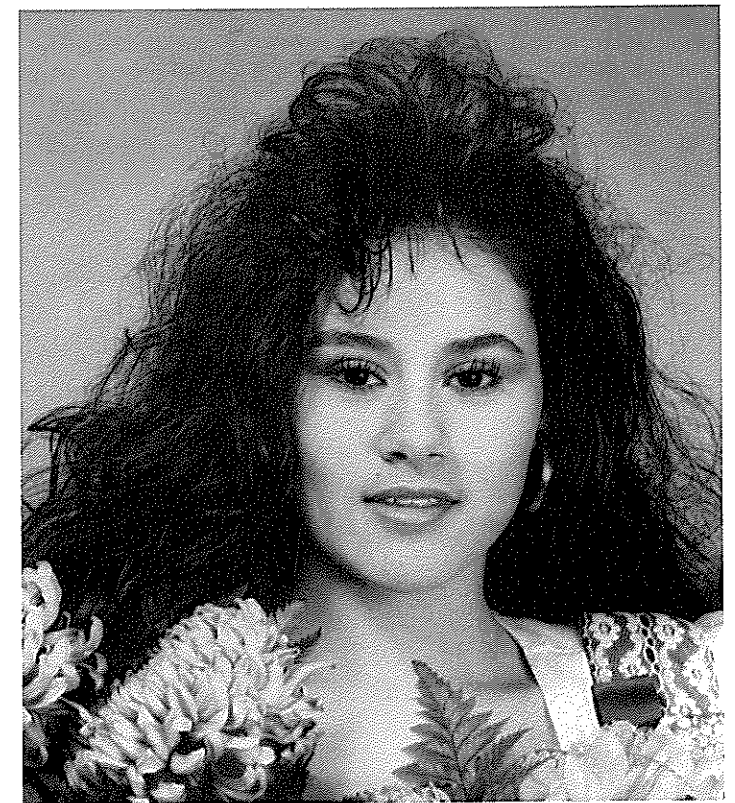
Victor Alvarado lights his part of the 1991-92 bon-fire.

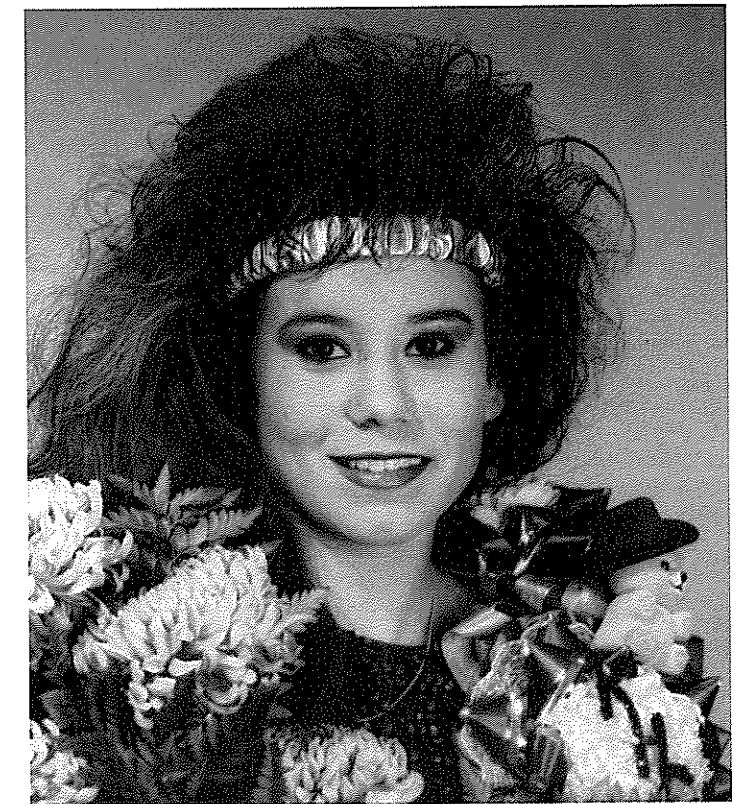
