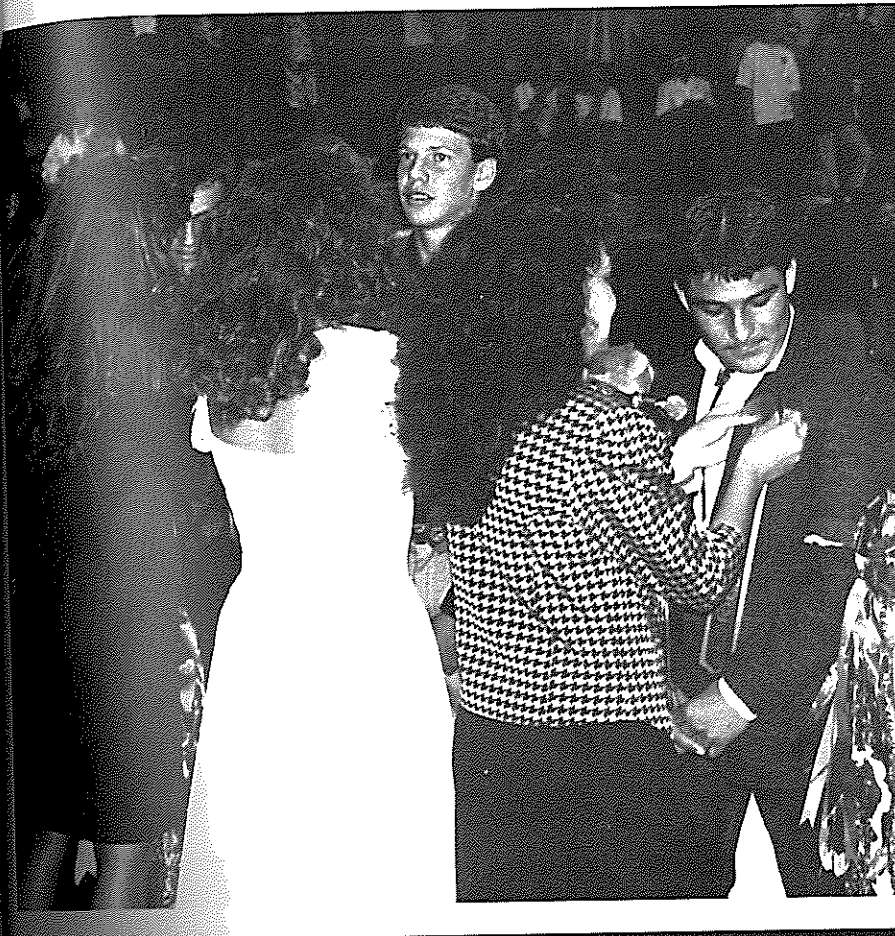
On Thursday before the game, the annual Bon Fire was held and it always generates a winning spirit.

Girls decorated the lockers of football players and groups, clubs and classes also got together to draw and paint their spirits on signs which were placed in the gym.

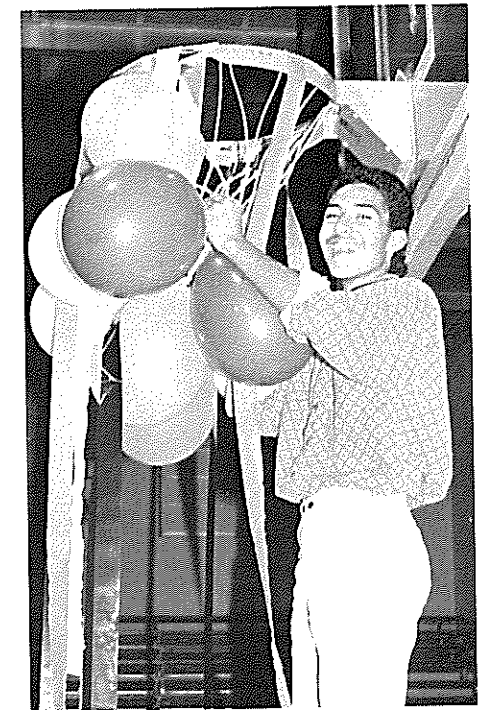

Bobby Riley lights the 1991 Bon Fire!



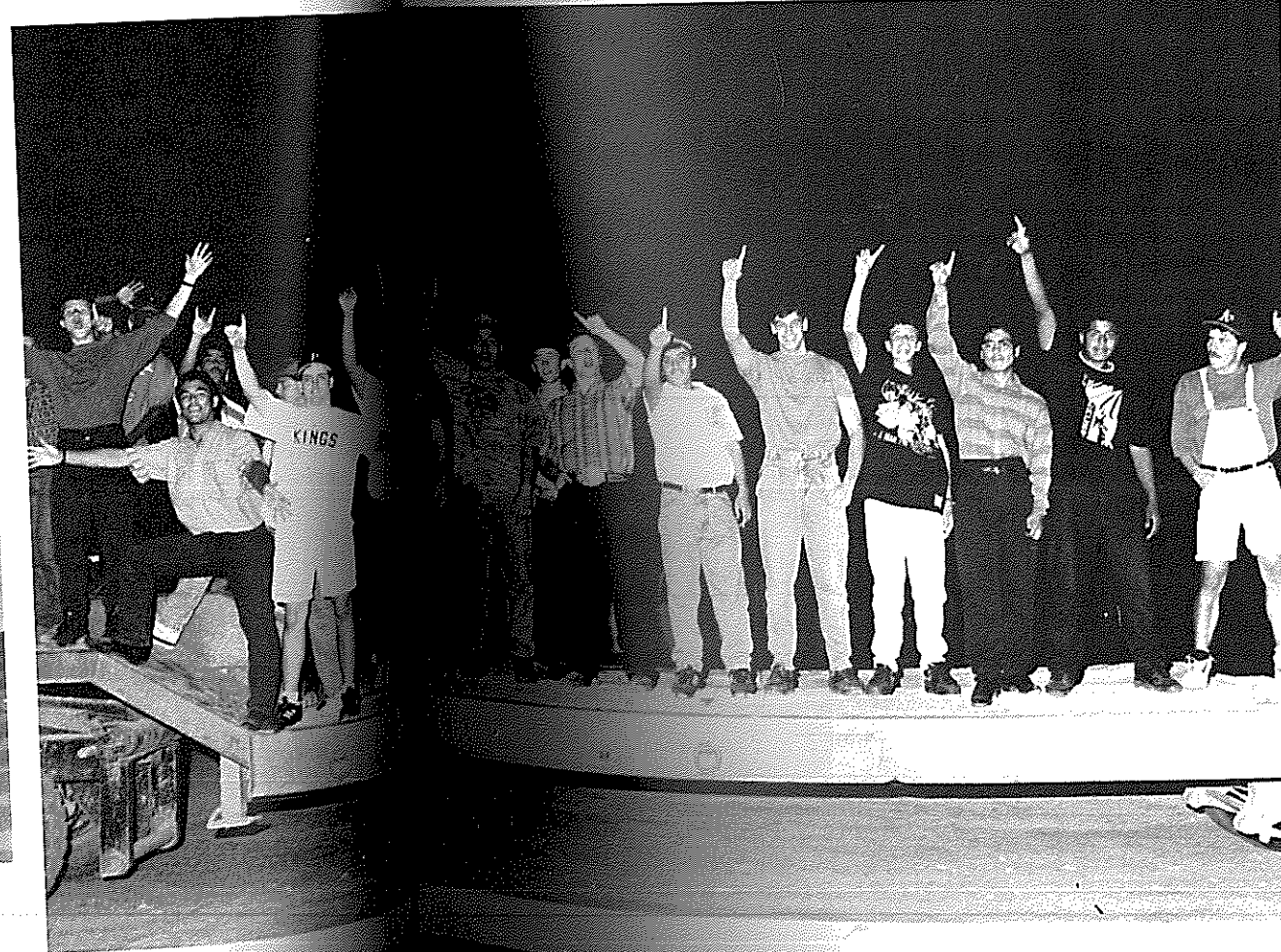
