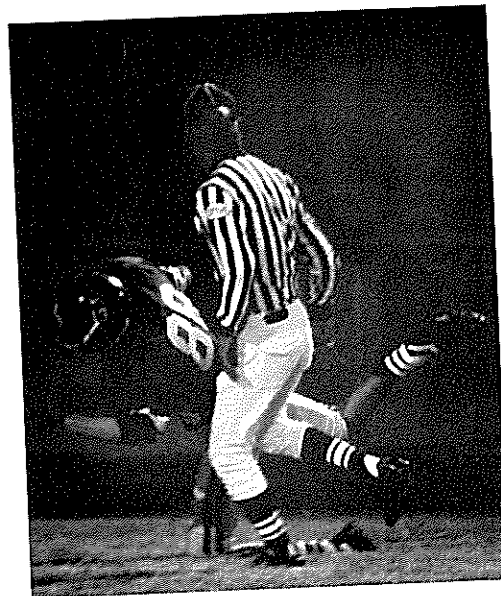
Roger Padron (24), Mauricio Orona (54), and Victor Alvarado (67) eliminate the competition.

The season started off slowly for the Jackets, but, before it was over, resulted in victories. The Jackets fought hard till the end.

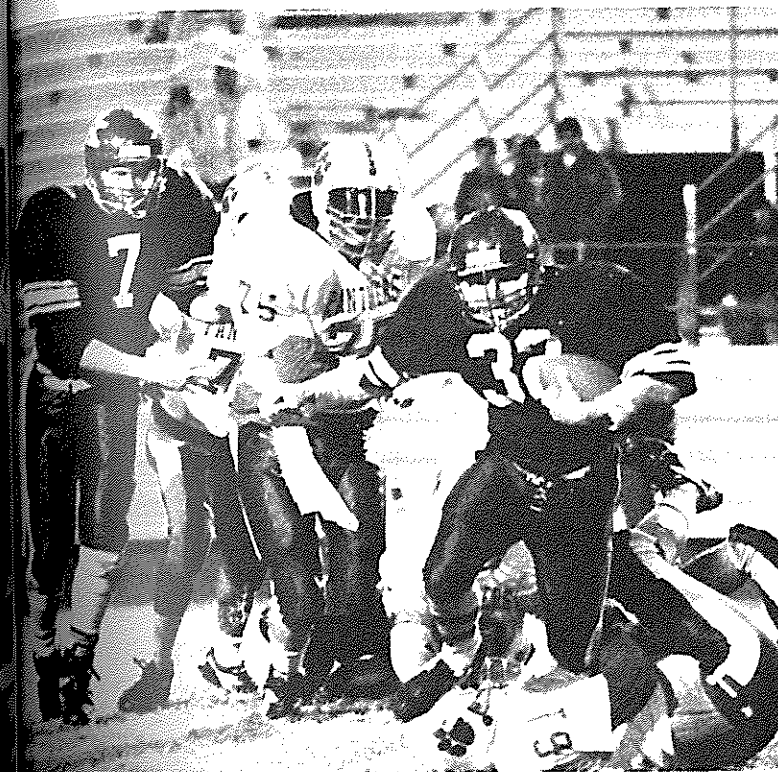
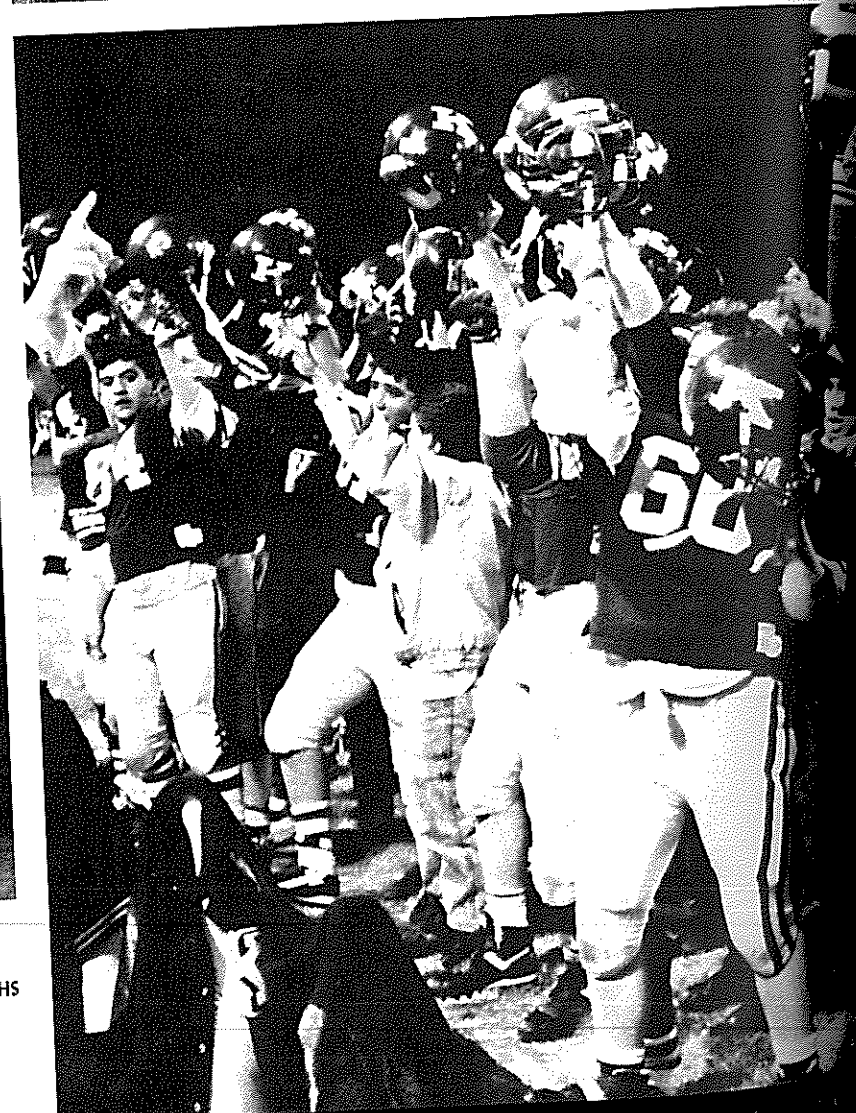
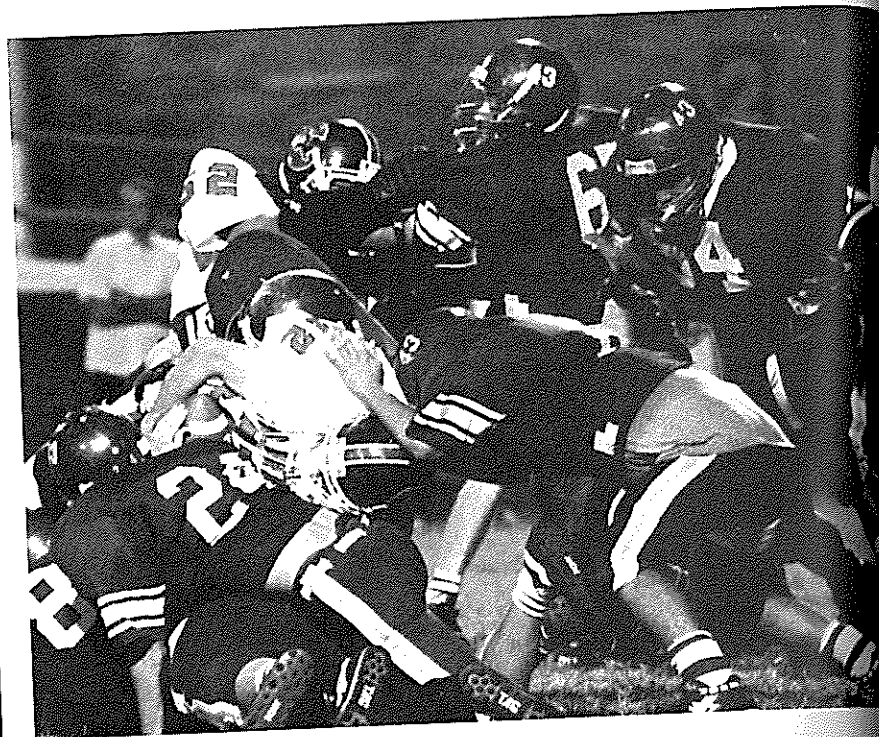

Bobby Riley (88) scores a touchdown.

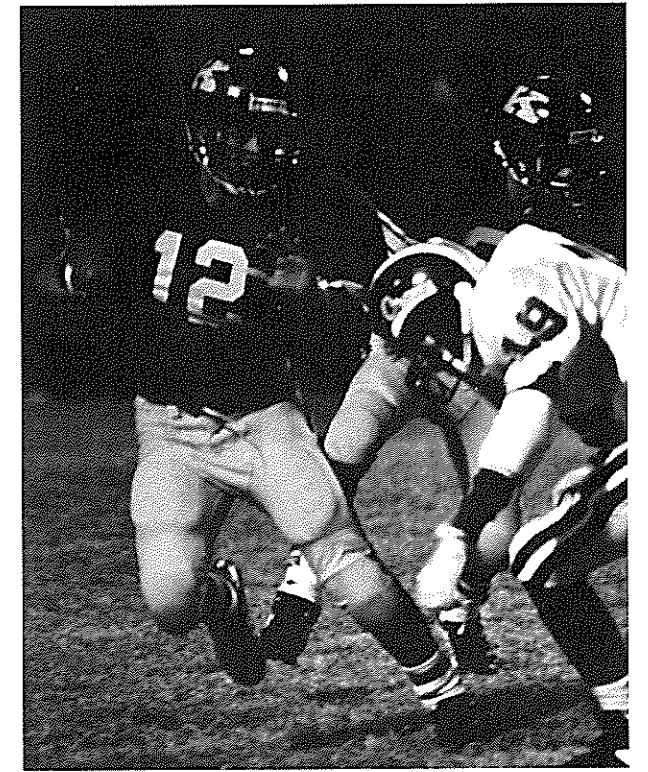
The Kermit Yellow Jackets raise their helmets to KHS after a victory over the Crane Golden Cranes.
