

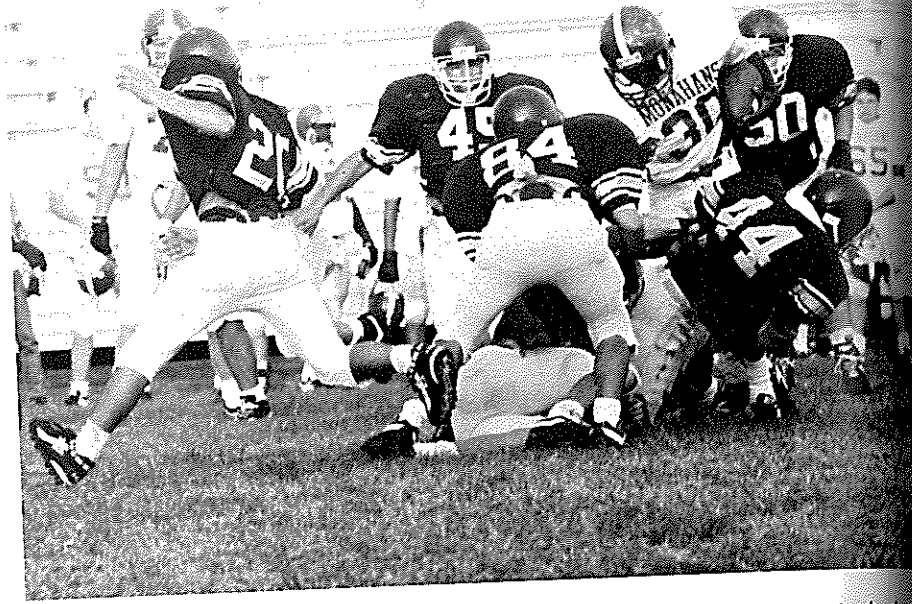
# Football Executed JV Style

The 1991 Kermit Yellow Jacket Junior Varsity football squad ended the season with three wins, five losses, and one tie.

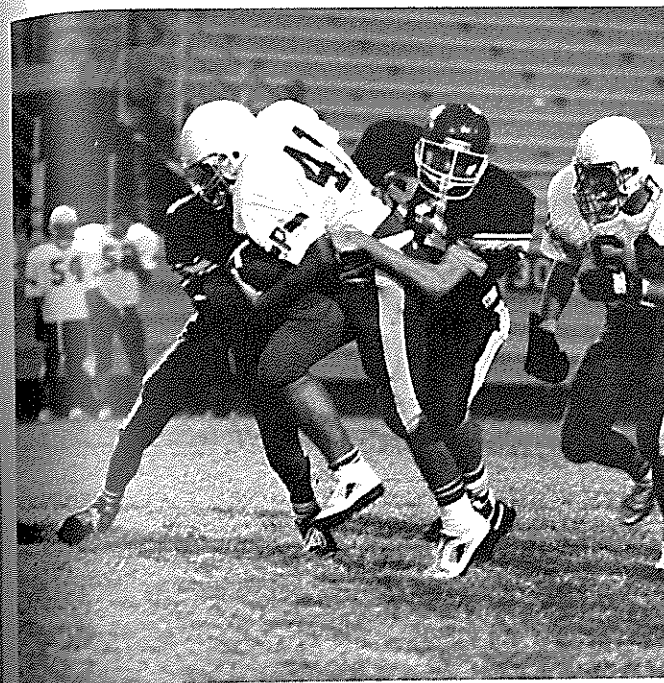
The first game of the season against the Seminole Indians resulted in a victory for the Jackets. The next five games were not so good ... the jackets lost all but one.

The Jackets came back in district play to win two of the four district games.

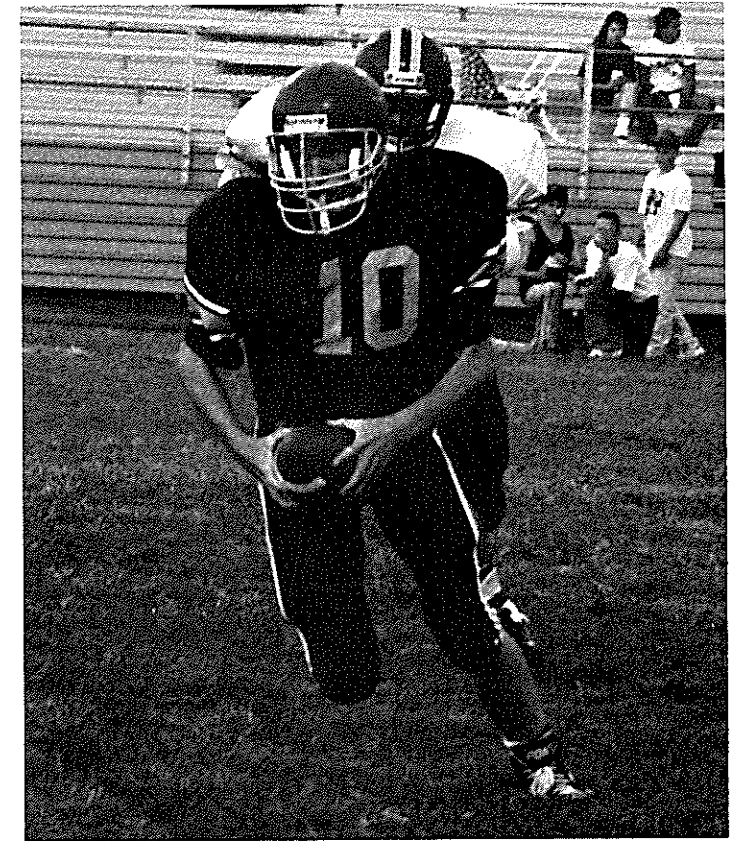

Ignacio Valenzuela (44), Justen Bradford (84), and Toby Payne (50) stop a Monahans running back.



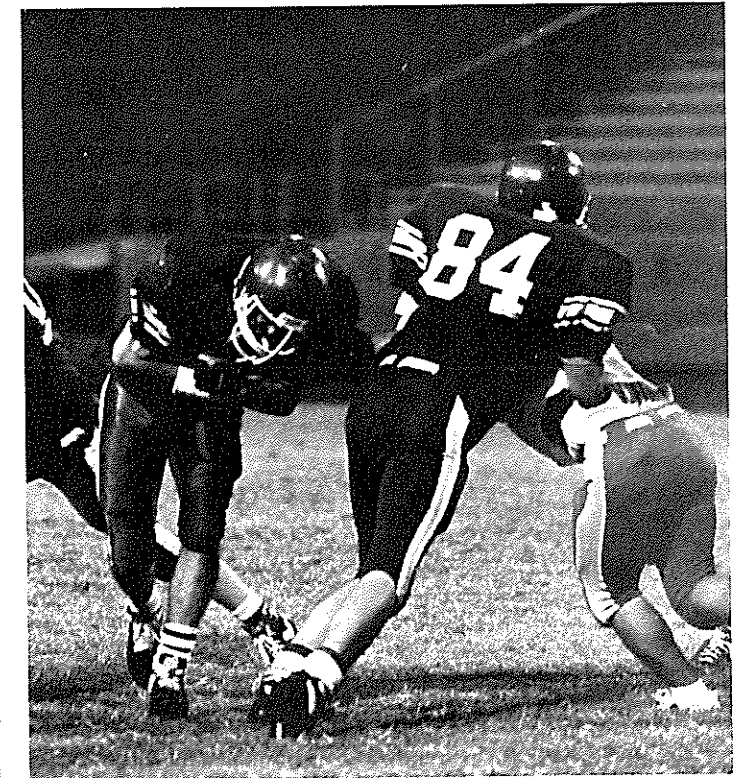
Justen Bradford (84) denies the opponent yardage.



Quarterback Ty Miller (10) leaves the opponent trailing.



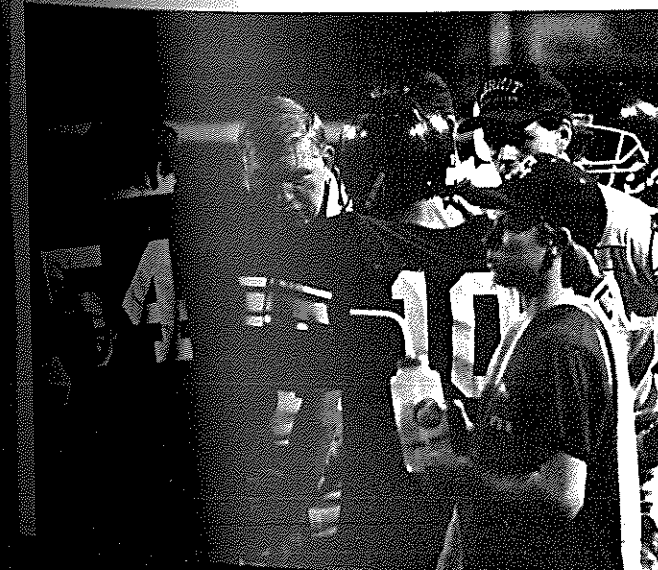
Ignacio Valenzuela (44) tackles the ball-carrier to end the play.
