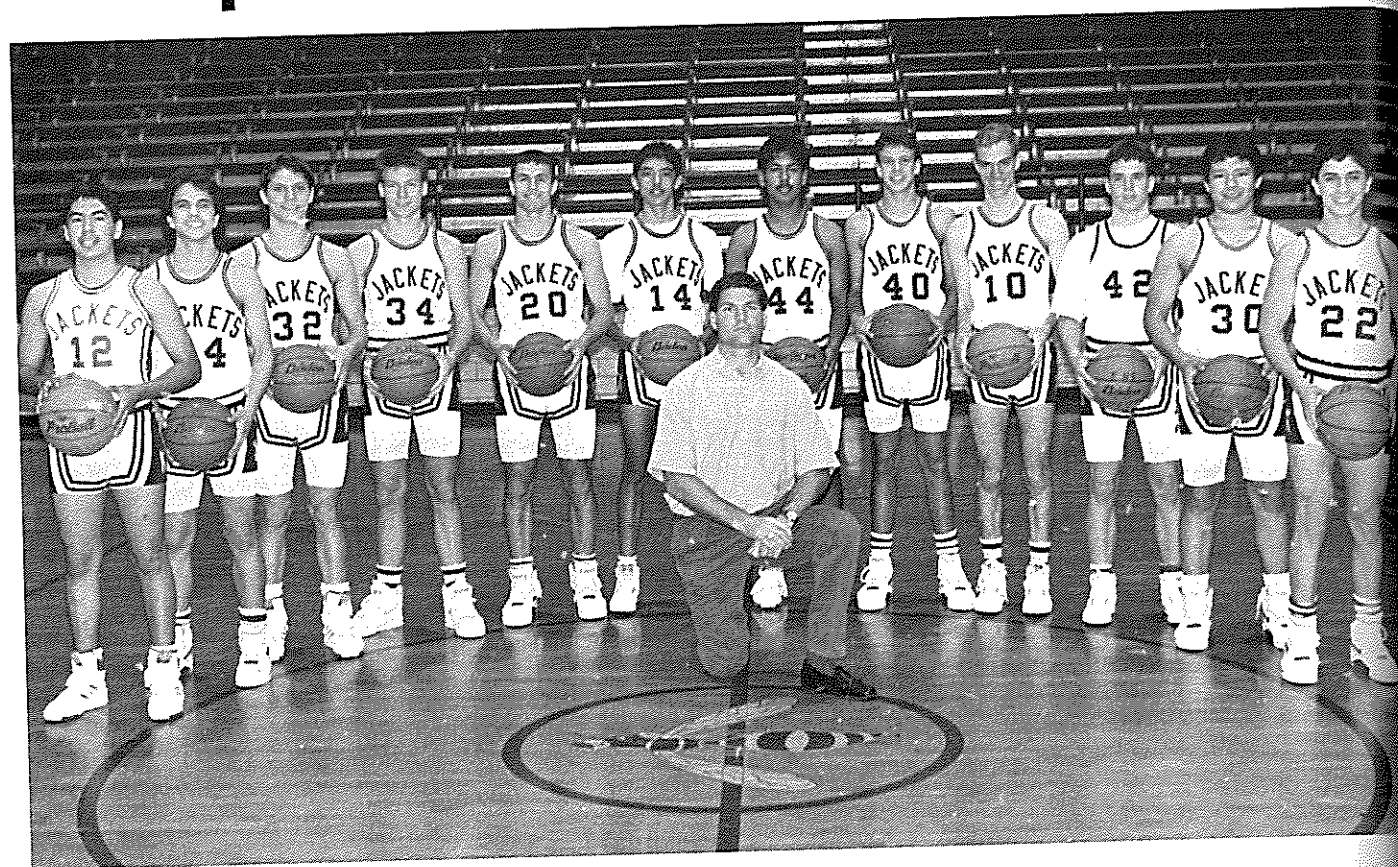
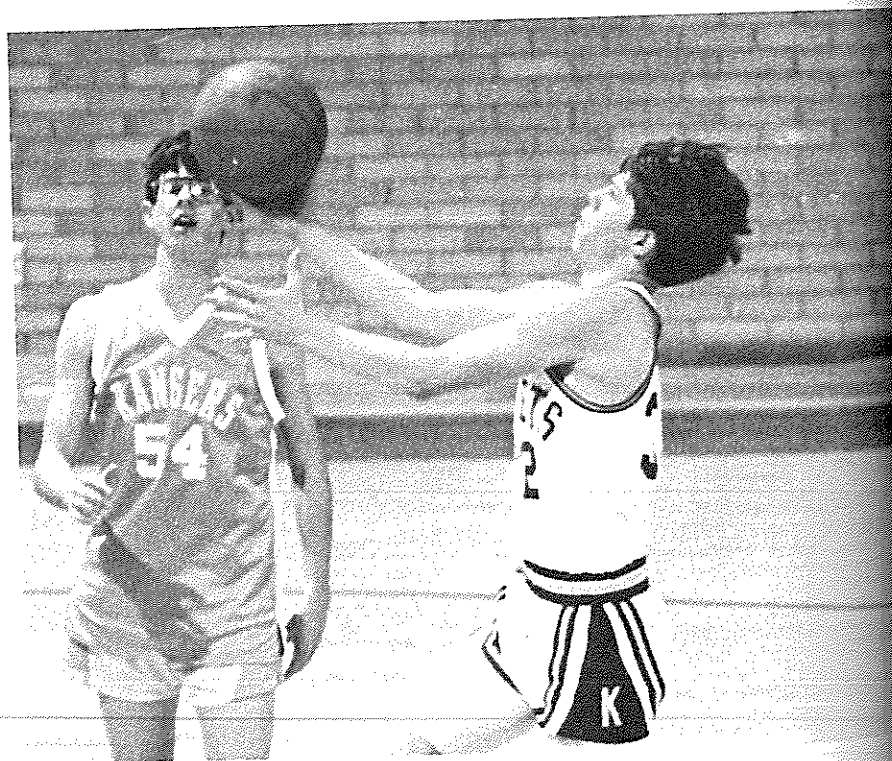


# JV Squad Has Good Season

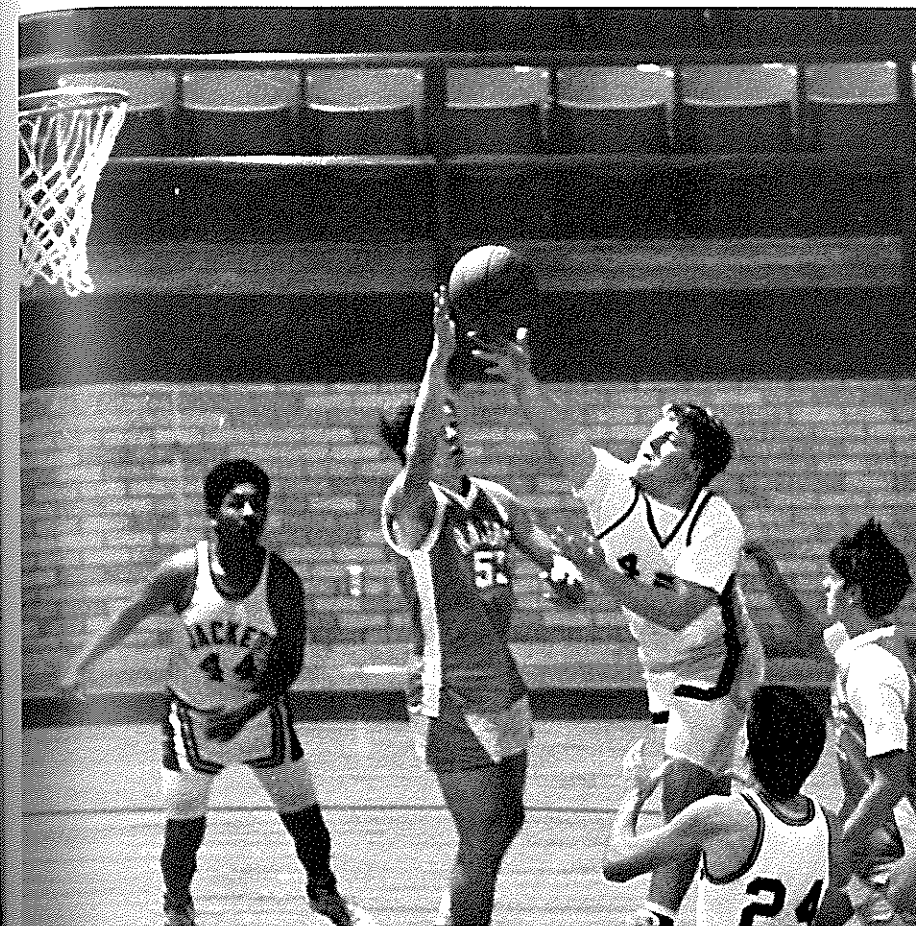

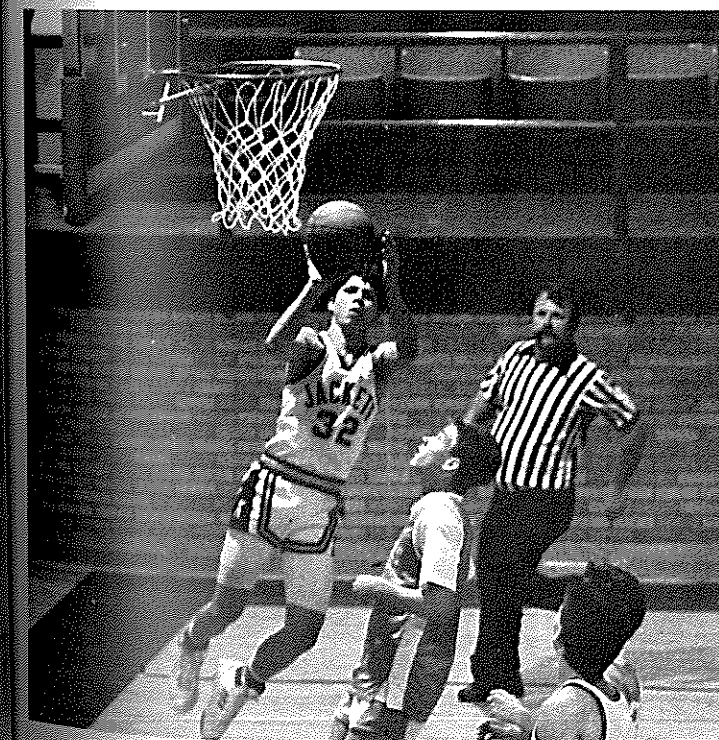
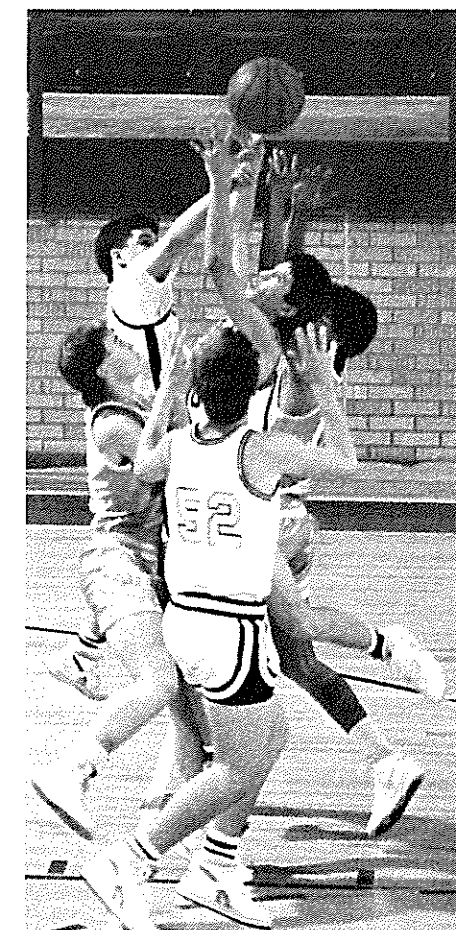


Willy Jolly puts up a sure shot for the Jackets.

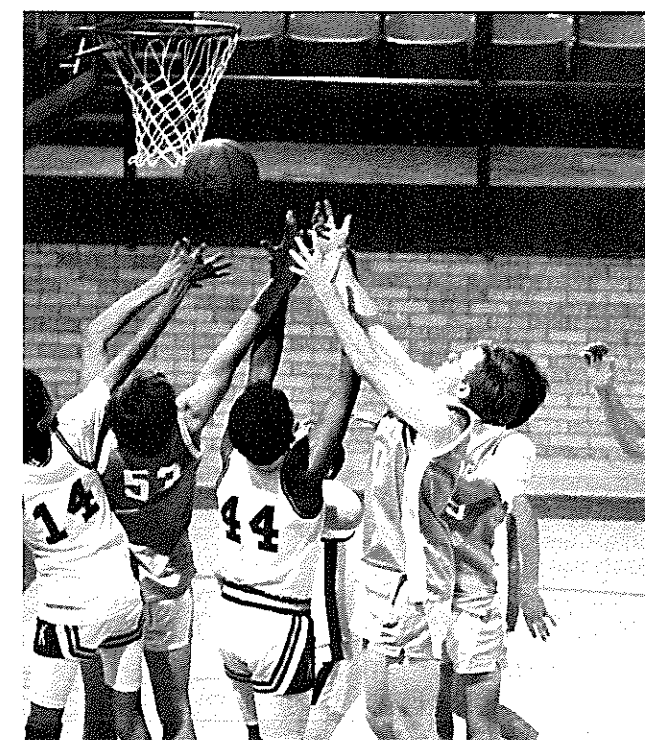


Toby Payne lays up a shot to complete a Yellow Jacket fast break.
