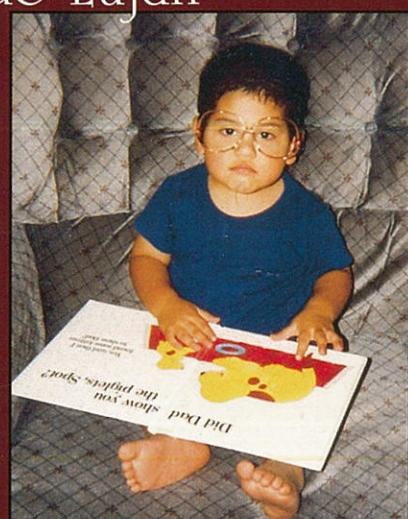
Dear Lindsay,
