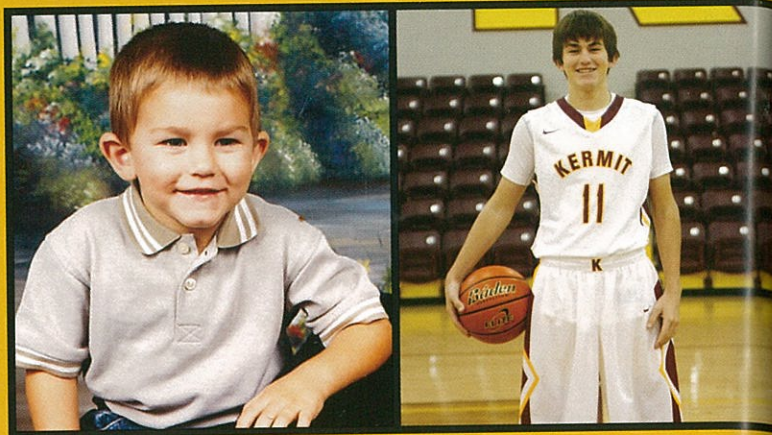


Jared,

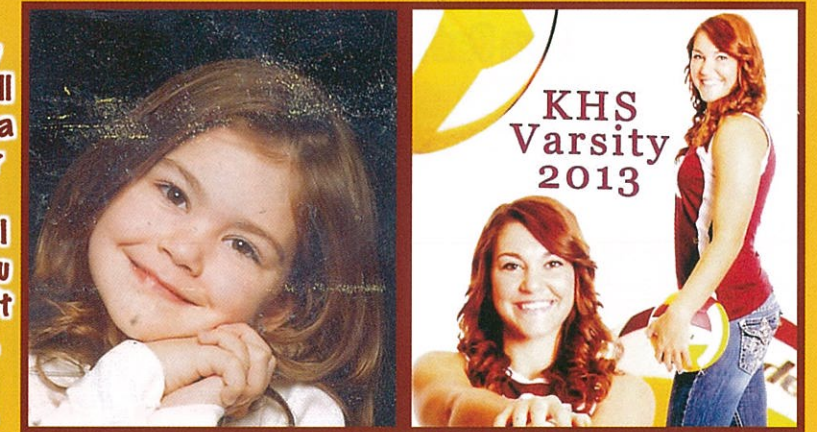

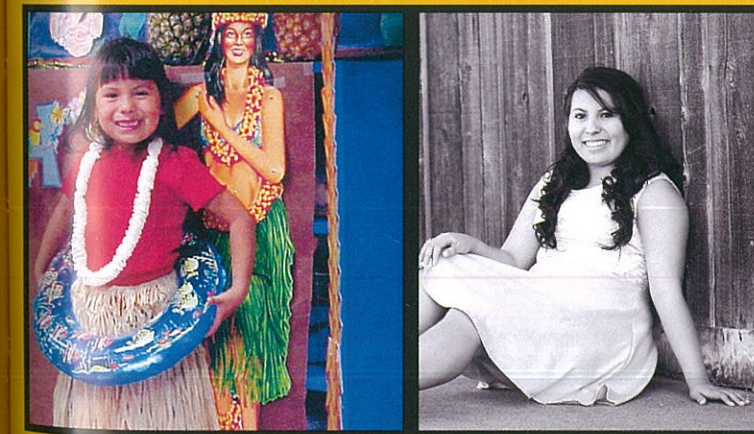

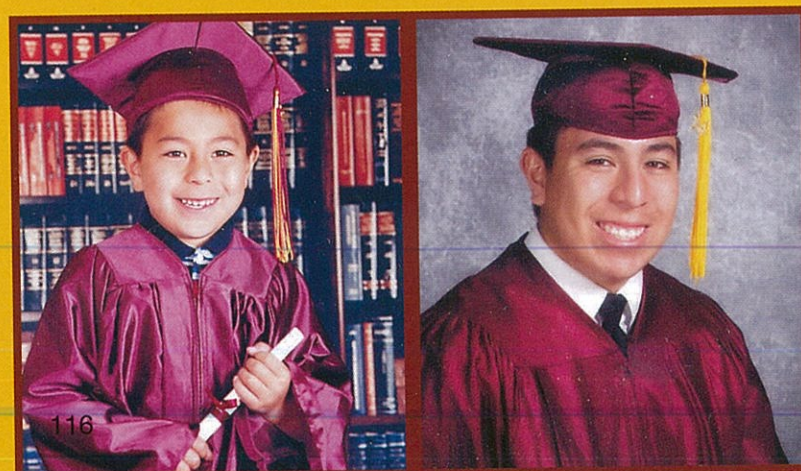
