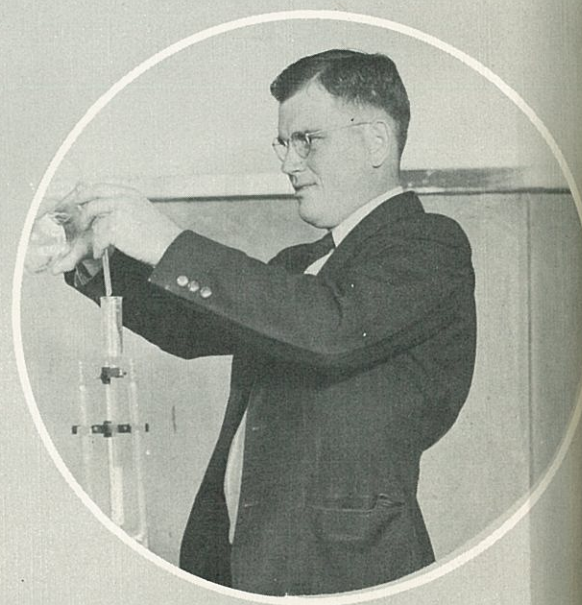
"Open House" in Wink is an annual affair. The scene below was taken during a demonstration on "Open House" night. The students are performing some experiments in chemistry.
