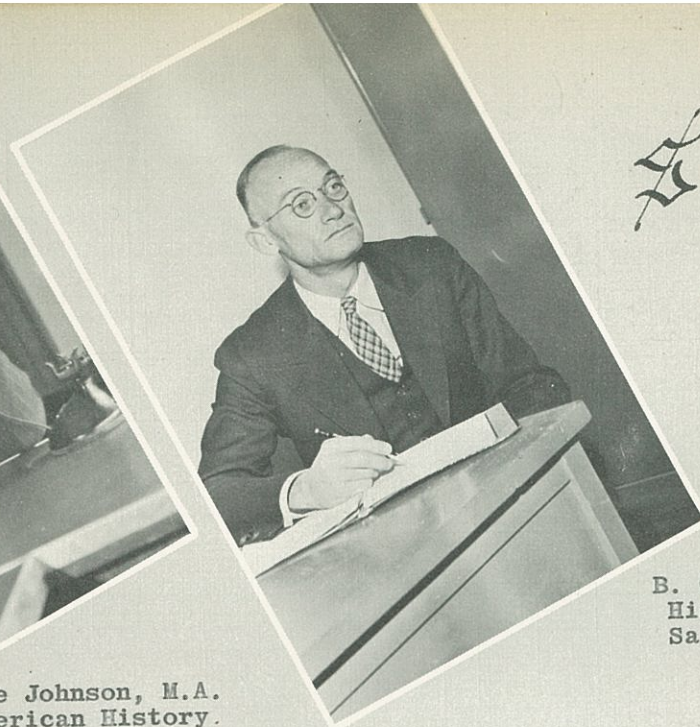

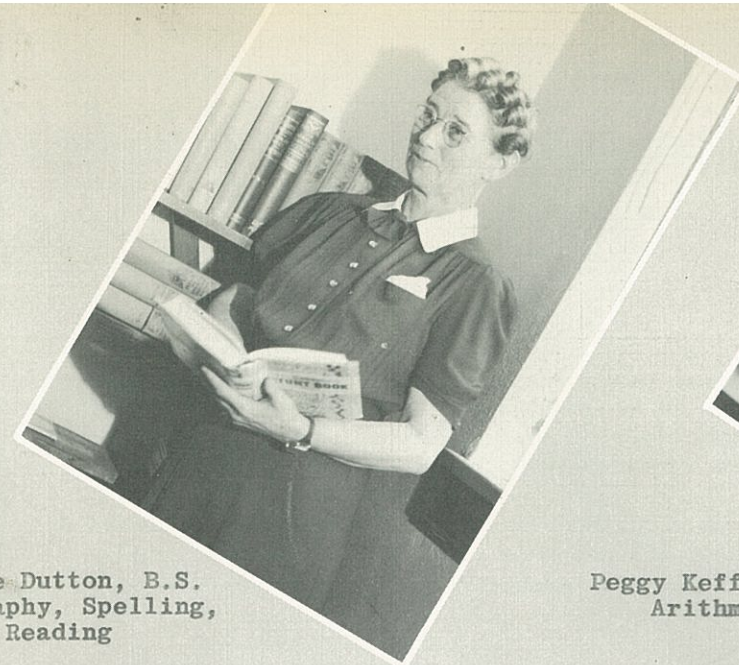


A class in American History.

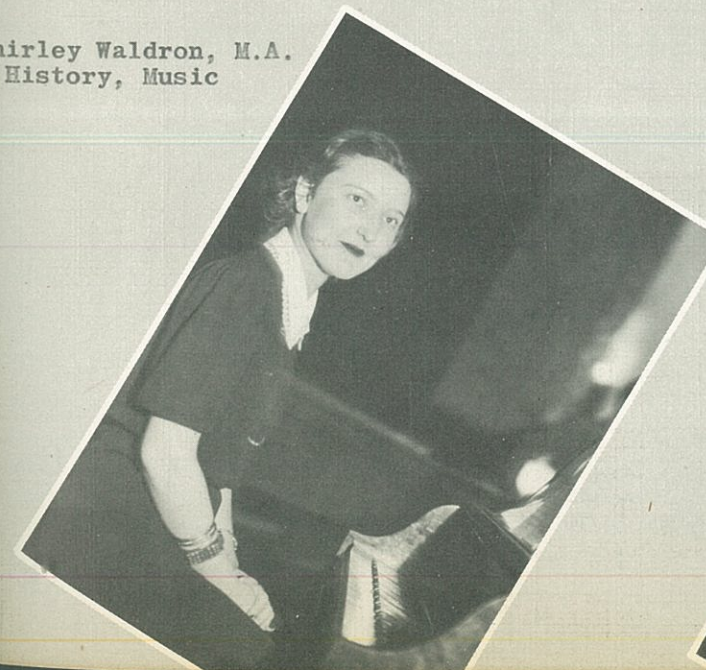
