



English - Every student is required to take English. One half of the year is devoted to grammar, and the other half to literature. Grammar gives us the mechanics of written and spoken English. In literature we mingle with the great minds of all ages, and seek to find that which is artistic and beautiful.

Typing - Typing, shorthand, bookkeeping, commercial arithmetic, and commercial law are offered.



Spanish - Two years of Spanish are offered. These courses are made interesting by introducing Spanish songs and customs. A special Spanish program is presented in assembly each year.



Bookkeeping - Besides the regular students, many post-graduates are interested in the Commercial Department.



Social Studies - This department consists of American History, World History, Texas History, Modern History, Civics, and Economics. American History is one of the required subjects for graduation.

Mathematics - Two years of Algebra, one year of general mathematics, plane geometry, and trigonometry are offered. The courses are made interesting by introducing unusual problems and by making everyday applications.
