"Just any kind of an exam."



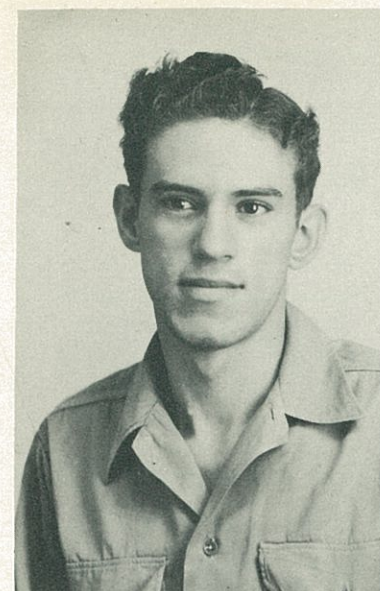
Margie McGann

And his pastime is romancing.



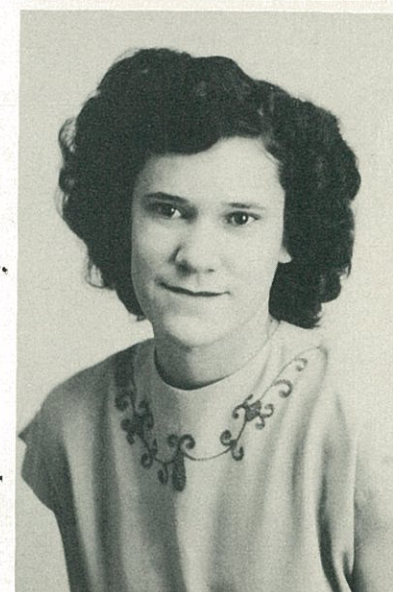
Alton Howse

And for food---steak and gravee.



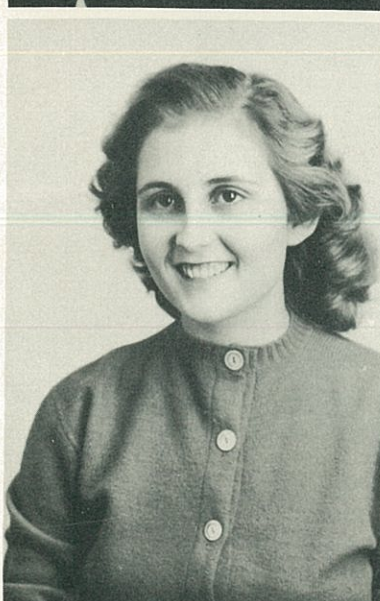
Janet Hopson Pearson
