go.



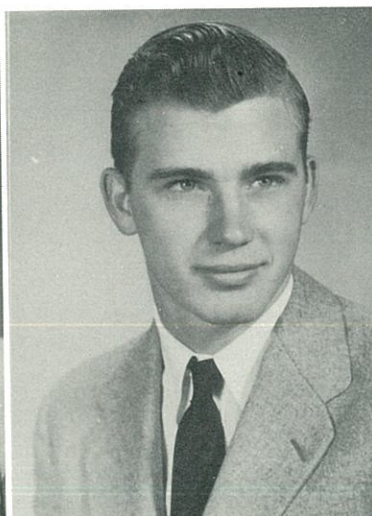
Tessie Hurst

test.



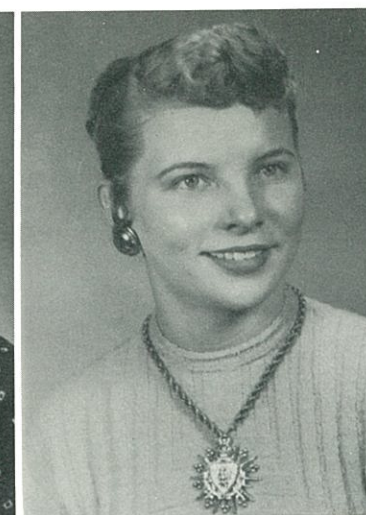
Annette Bailey

ward.



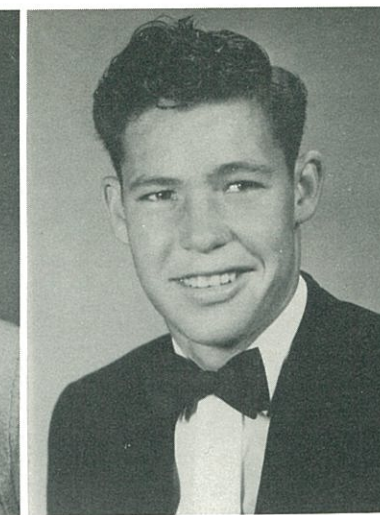
LaNelle Gray

never lacks.



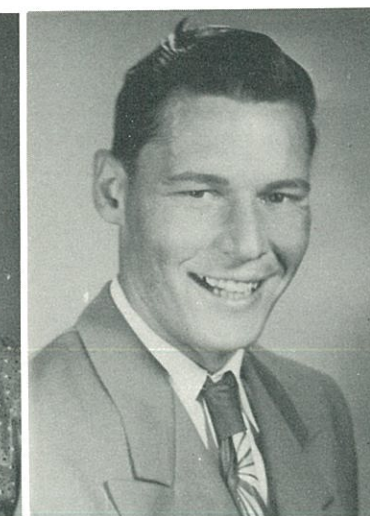
Marion D. Barnes
