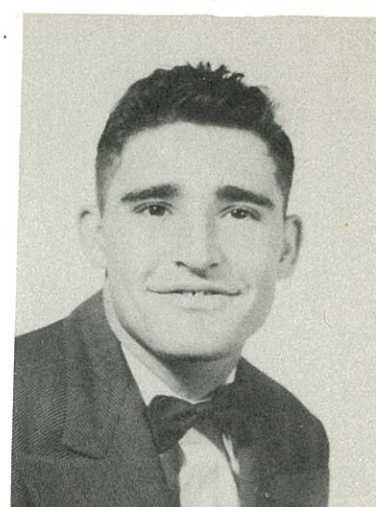


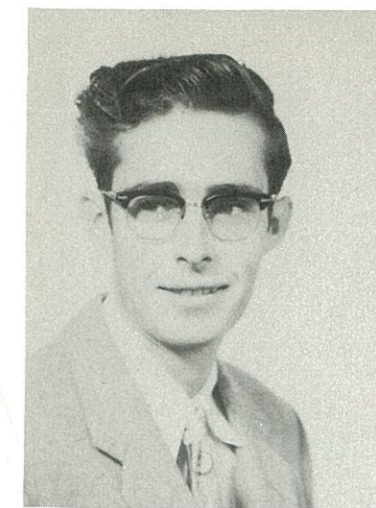
Dwight Forga

 That are always in style.



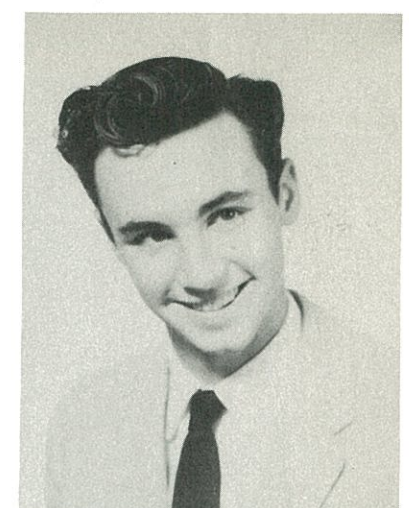
Donnie Hatcher

 That brings girls' sighs.



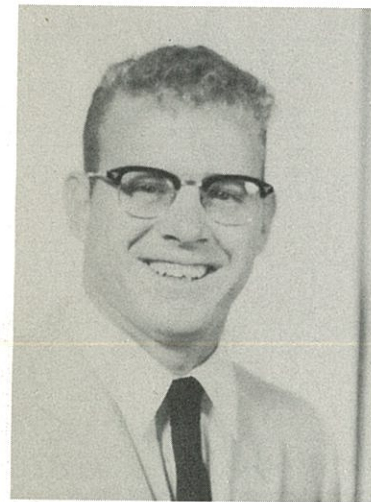
Edward Landry

 But Jack doesn't mind a bit.



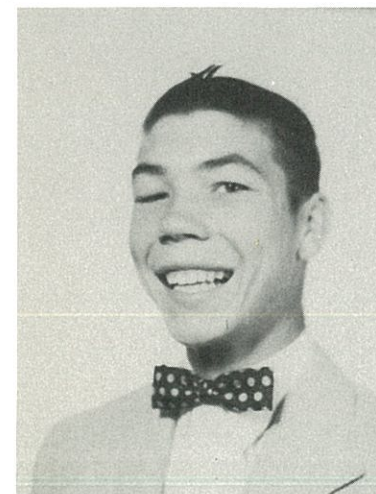
Donald Hook

 Could never be had.



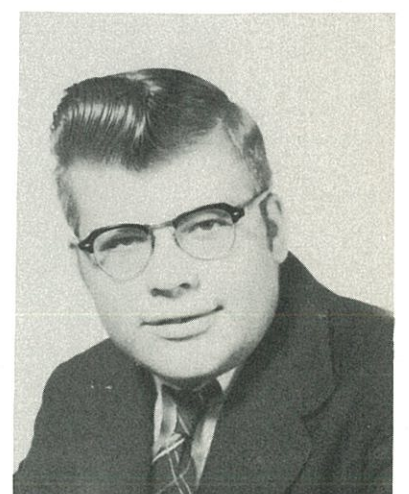
Ronald Hook
