

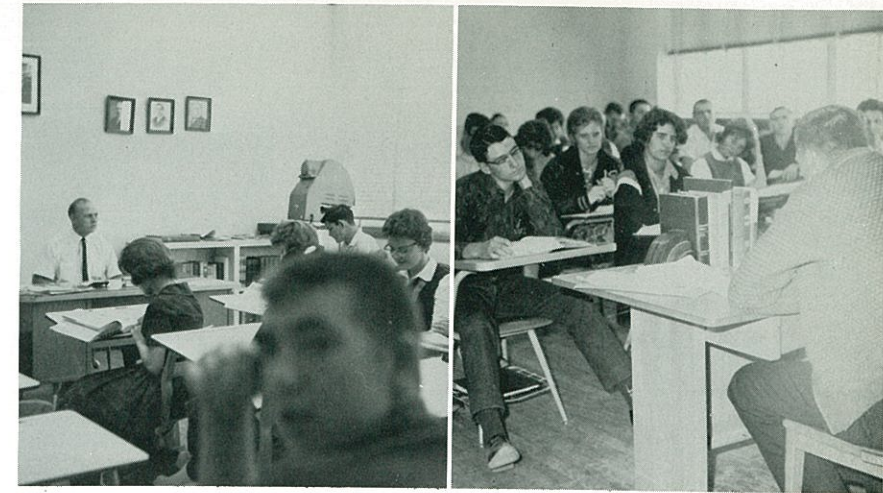
Science

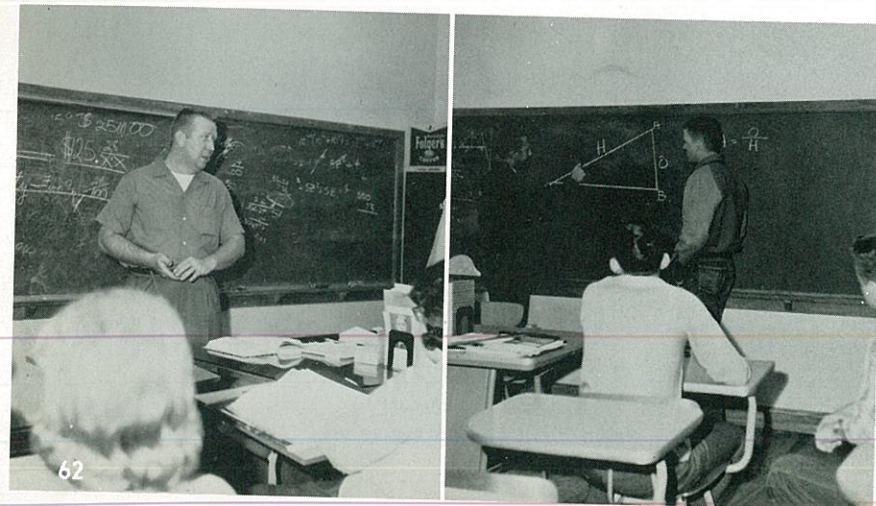
English
