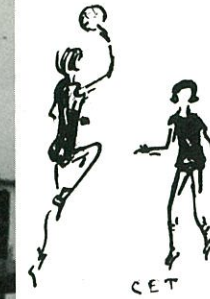


Business

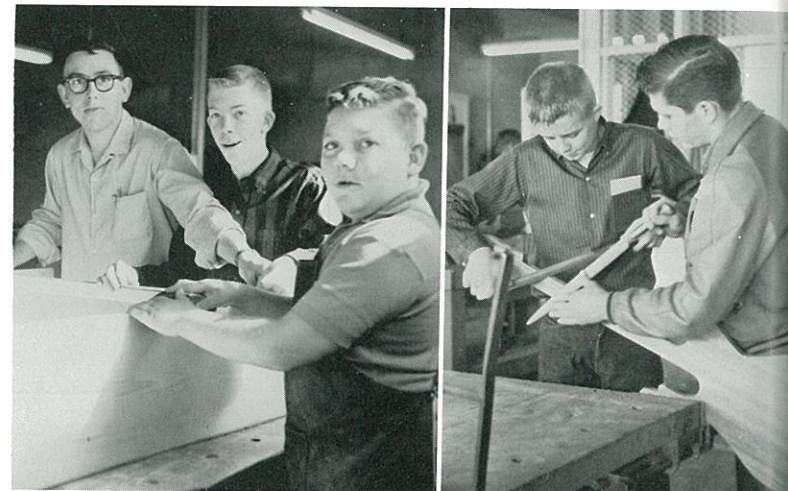


Physical Education
