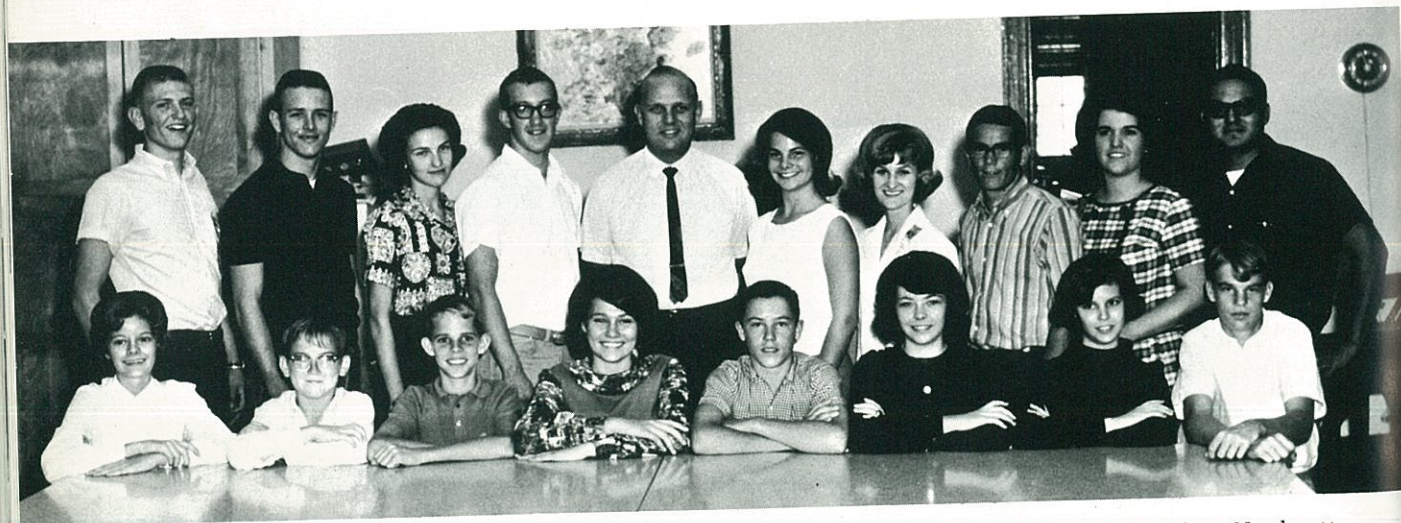


Spring Election of Officers Stirs Enthusiasm, Oratory and Artistic Talent
