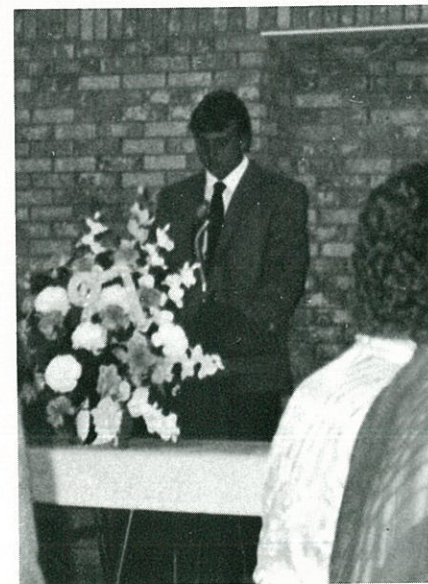


Never Say Good-Bye . . .
