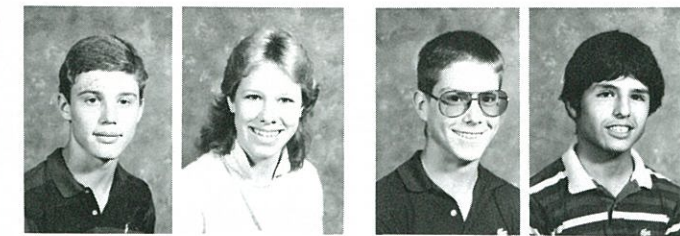
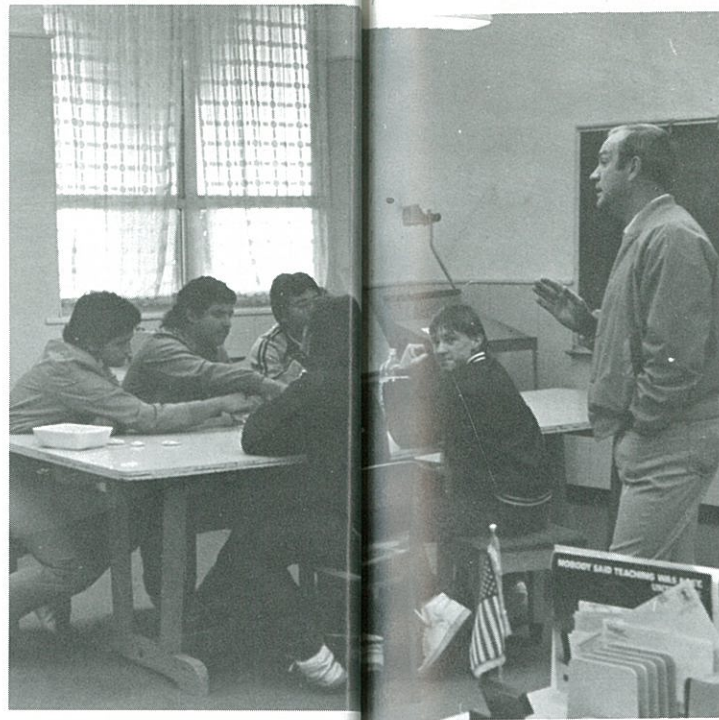
"The scariest thing about becoming a freshman is trying to make the sports teams, knowing you have a lot of competition from upperclassmen."

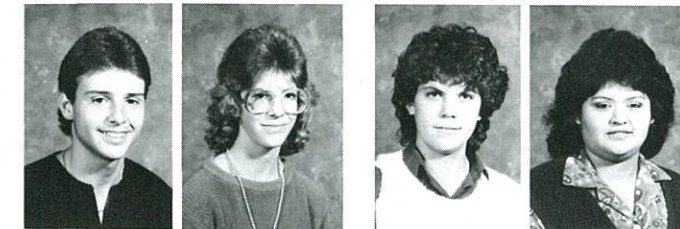
Even out of class, Coach Criswell is still giving lectures. But Jerome, George, and Lorenzo are eating and paying no attention to him.
