

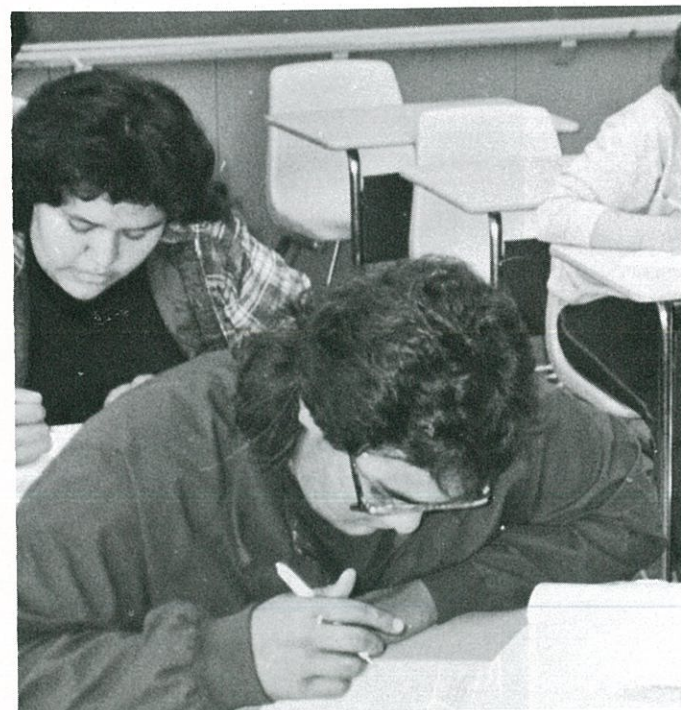
Making History
