

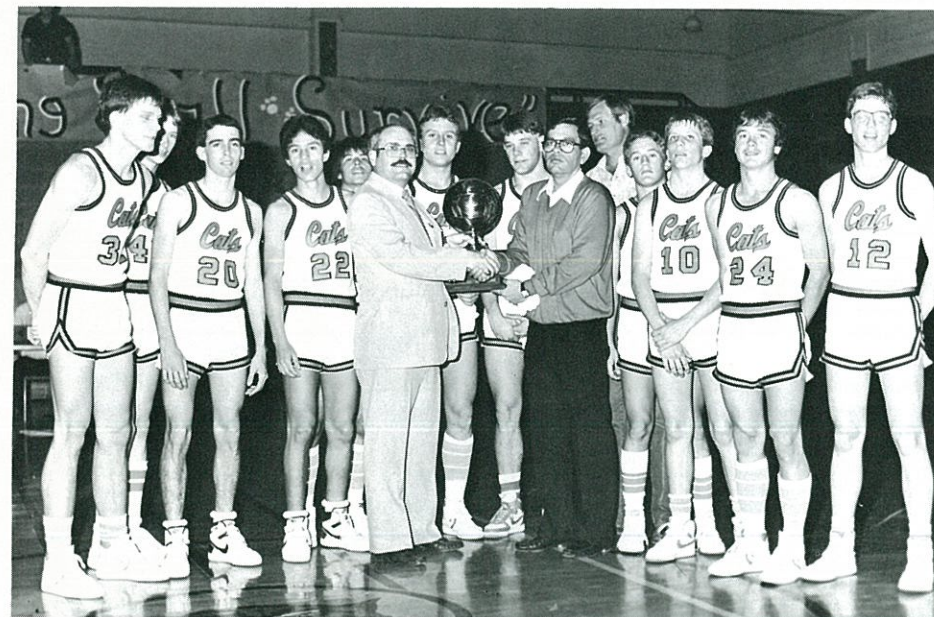

When the season was over the team had played 26 games and all five starters had scored over 200 points. They had won the District Championship and finished with a winning record of 13-13. Congratulations!

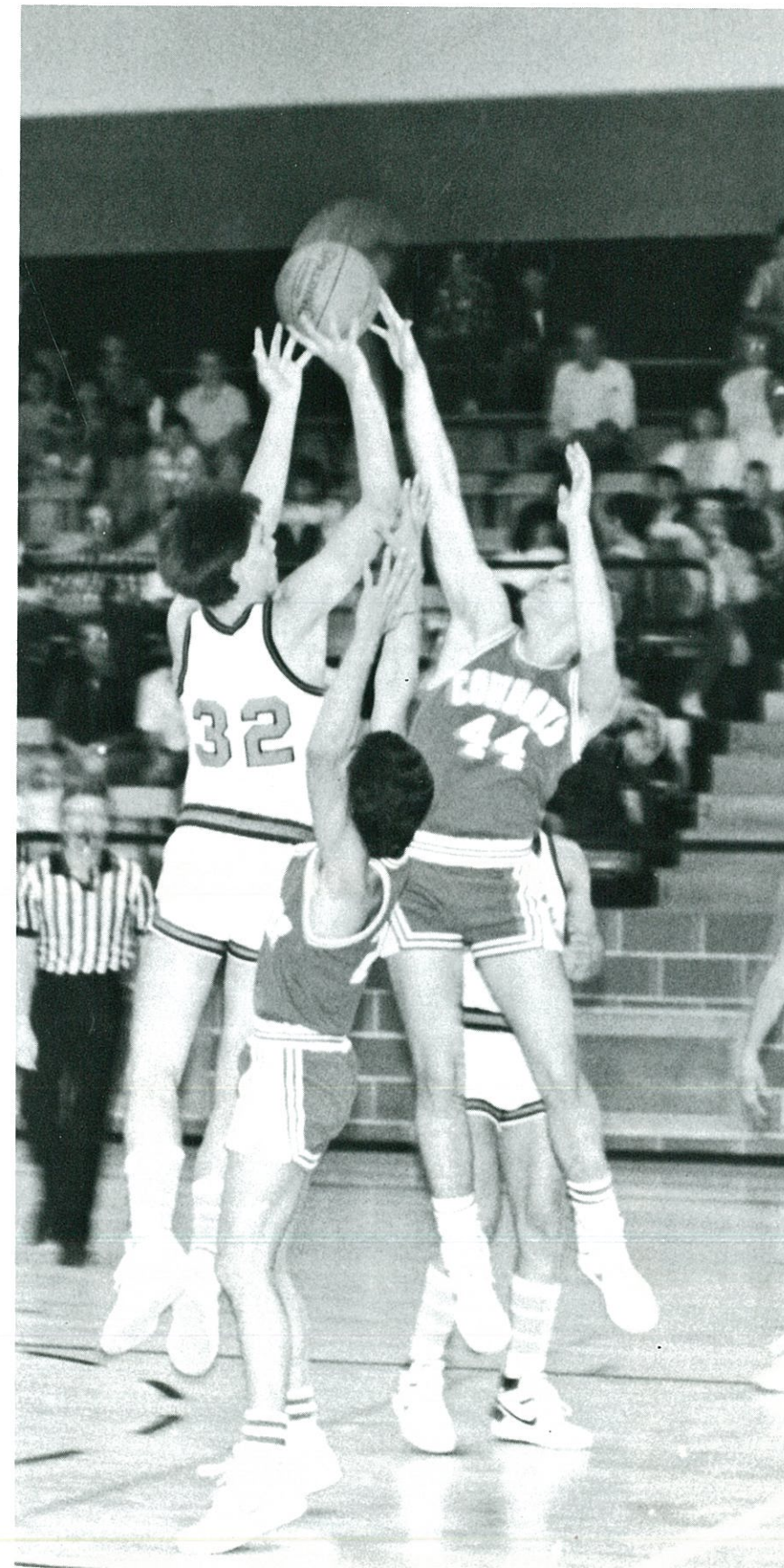
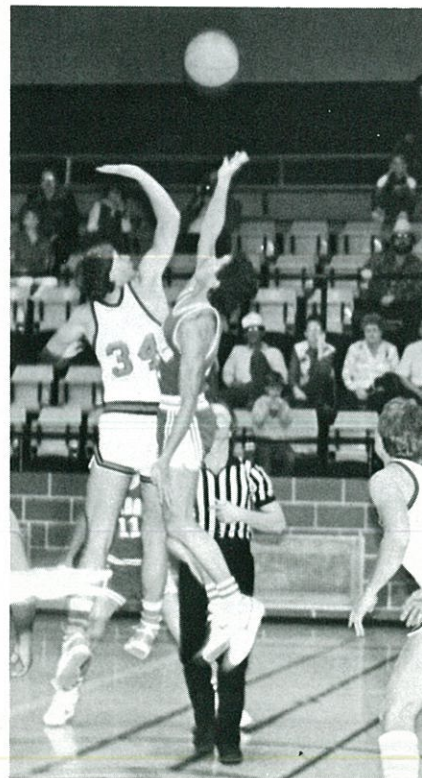
