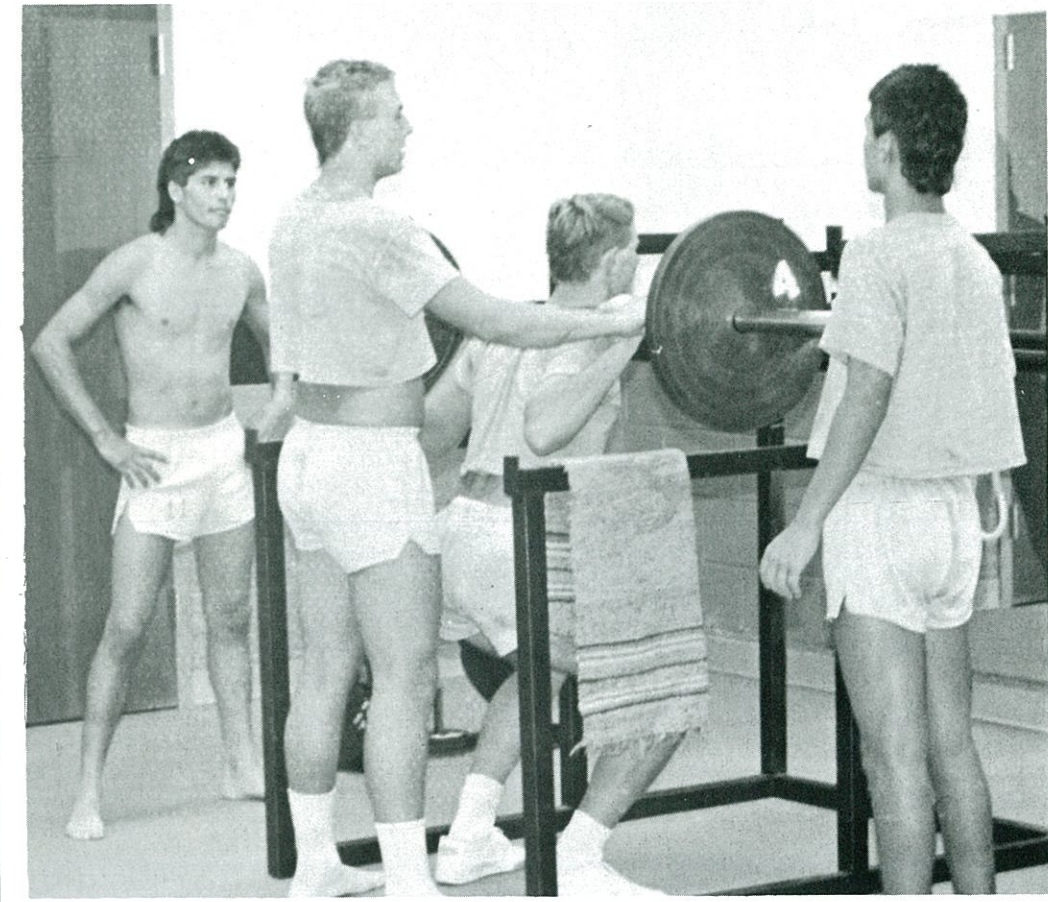
Playing racketball is one of Betty Riddle's favorite pastimes. As she was shown here smashing the ball for a needed point.



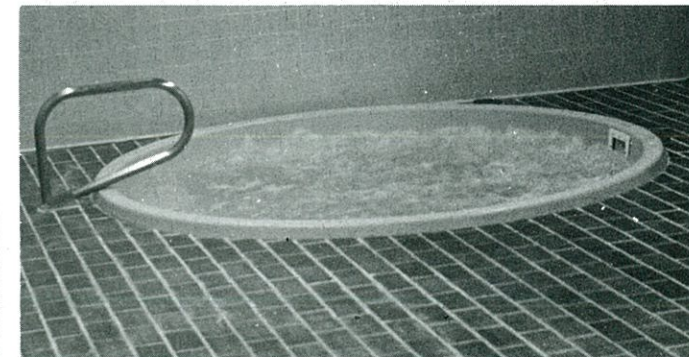
