

And We Know How To Use It!

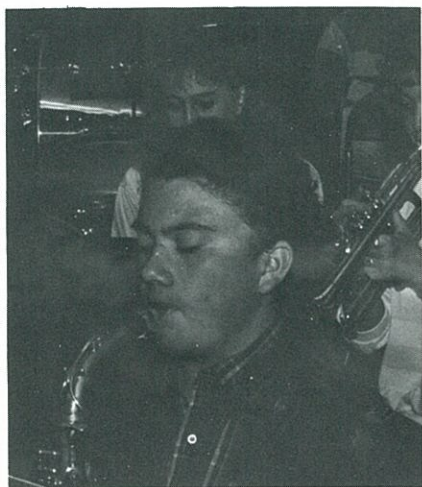
The band took part in the Christmas parade. Most members enjoyed being in the parade, some even managed smiles.

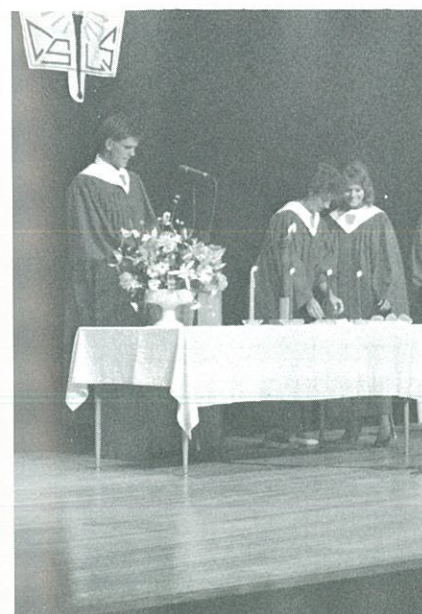

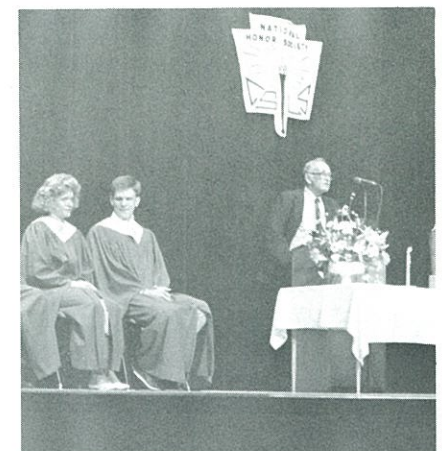
Leadership is something a person works for; It isn't handed down on a silver platter. Honor Society gives students the recognition they deserve.

Alisa Gray further explained the meaning of the initiation of the Honor Society.

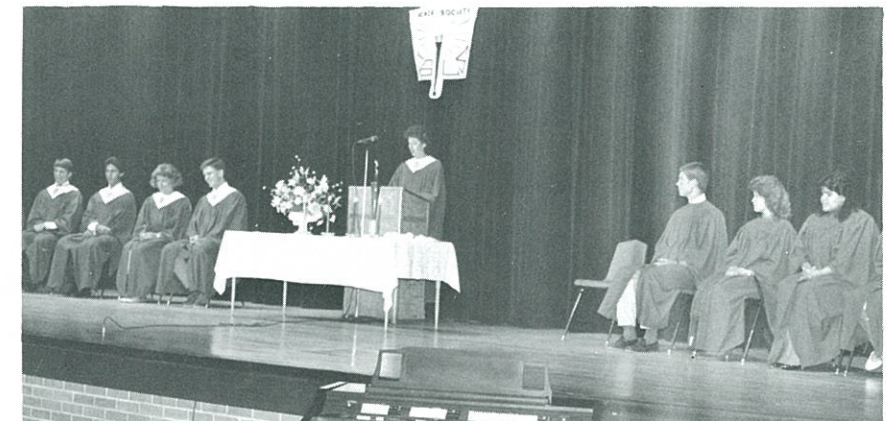
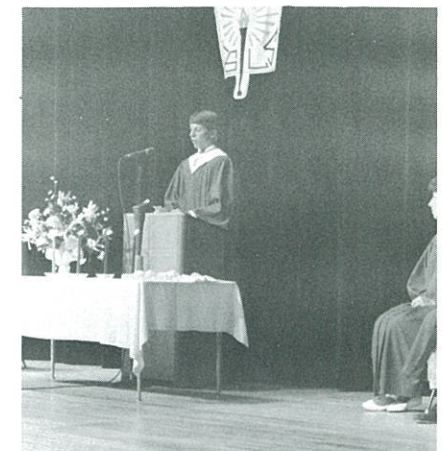


Danny announced the new members as Amy presented Niki with her honor pendant.
