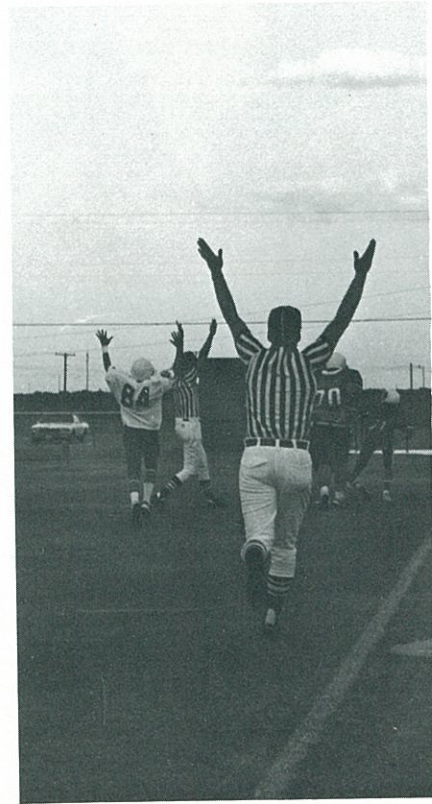


# Stepping Up!

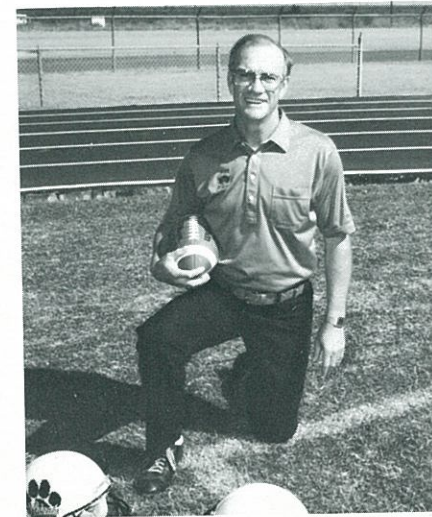
