

The 1990 track season went fairly well for the Wink Wildcats. Wink track members put in long, hard hours of work to be the best that they could be. This showed in their district and regional records.

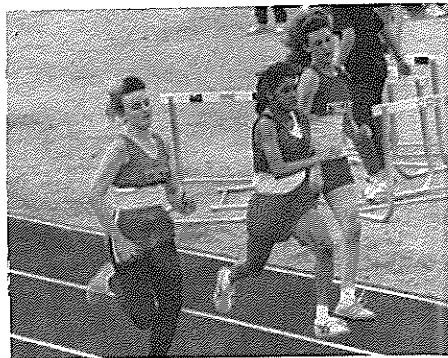

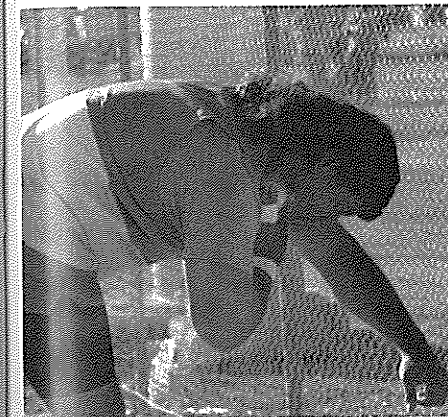
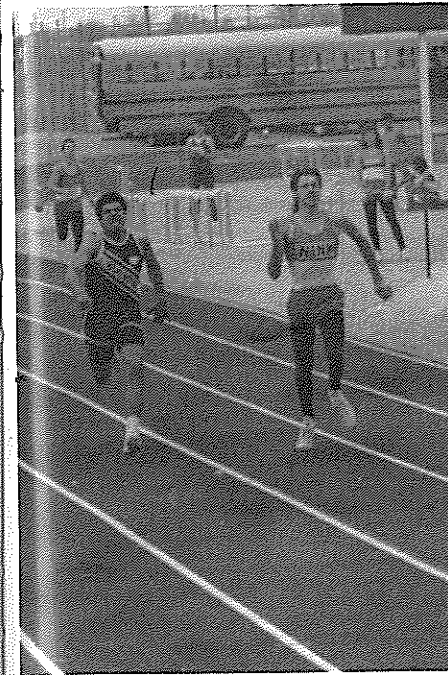
Wink track participants take a break during the district track meet to rest and have their picture taken.

Shellie Yates, district champion and regional qualifier in the shot, placed third at the regional track meet.

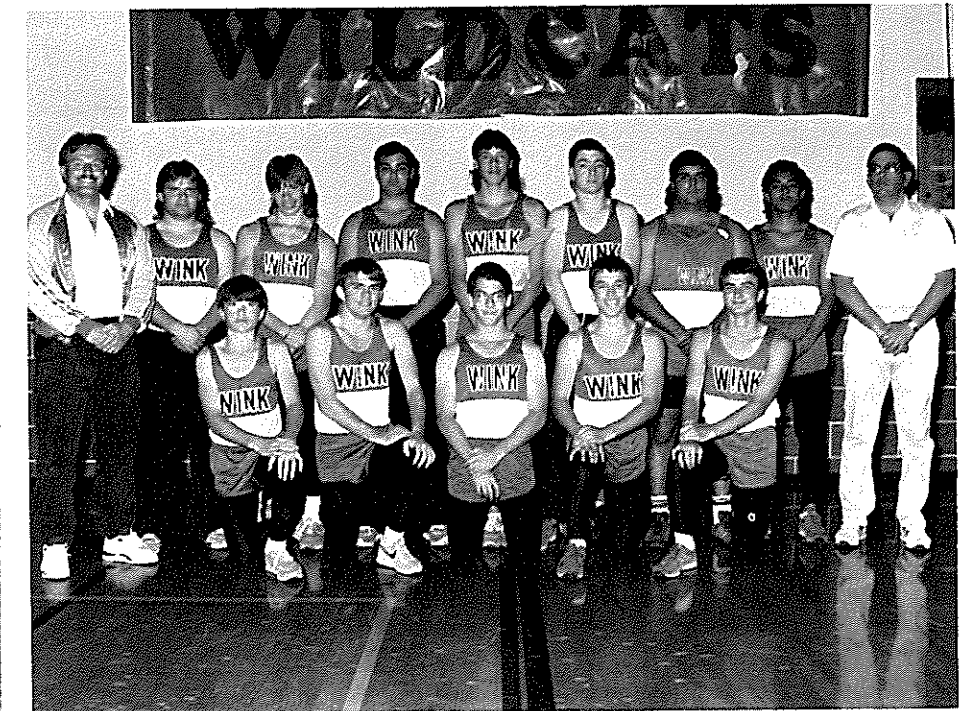


George Ramirez, regional qualifier in the shot and discus, is shown here at Pecos where he threw his furthest throw of the year.
