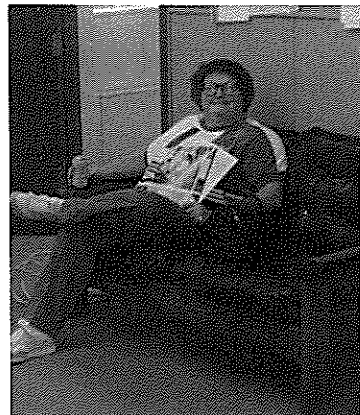


Mr. Nichols, Mrs. Jacobsen and Mrs. Criswell were waiting to give Coach Carrillo his birthday balloons during lunch.

Mrs. McCallister, Mrs. Thomas, and Miss Harris, all enjoy the new "off" period or Activity Period.



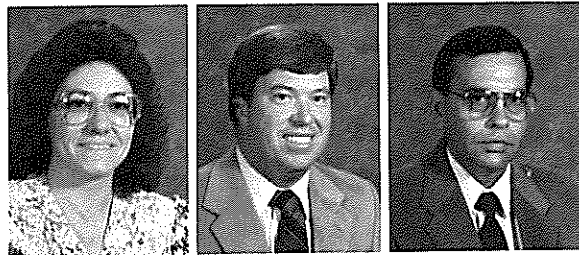

This year classes have been shortened to allow time for activity period which teachers and students use for different purposes.

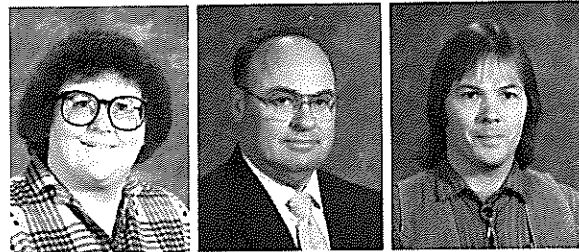
Some teachers have spent this time in the cafeteria, working with tutorials or in the auditorium helping the classes they sponsor work on their class assemblies.

Mr. Criswell, Mrs. Loftin and Mrs. Cole talk happily in the teacher's lounge at lunch during Red Ribbon Week.

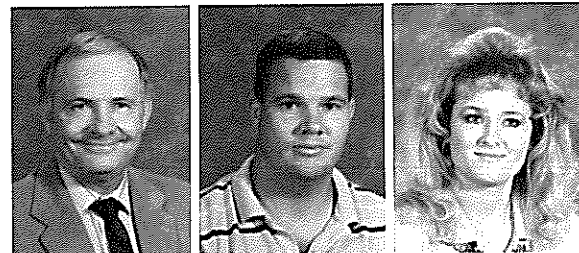
