The Jr. High football team did an excellent job this season also. Their record was 4 - 2. These fellows keep getting better and better all the time.

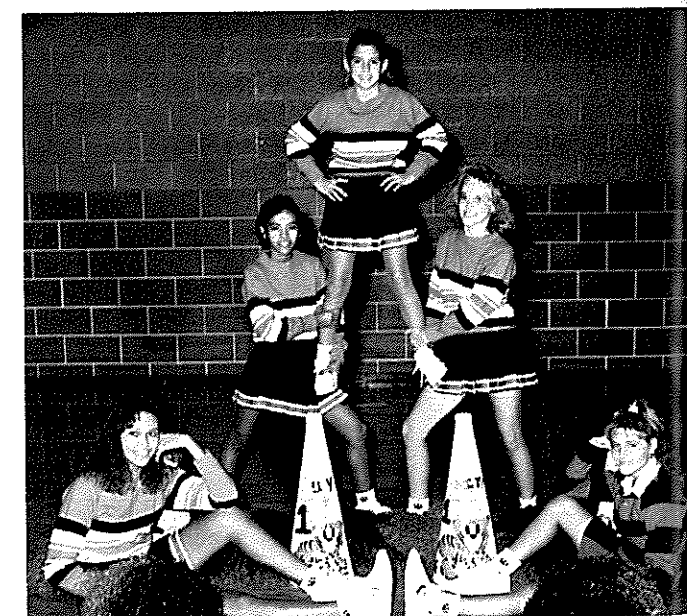
These athletes couldn't have done their job without the coaches. So thanks a bunch Coach Harris, Coach Nichols, And Coach Thomas.

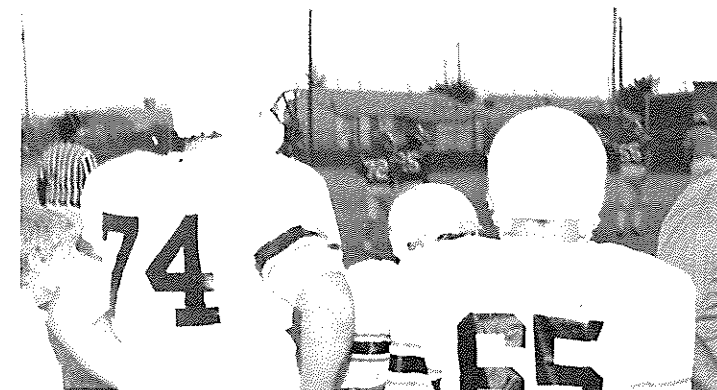
