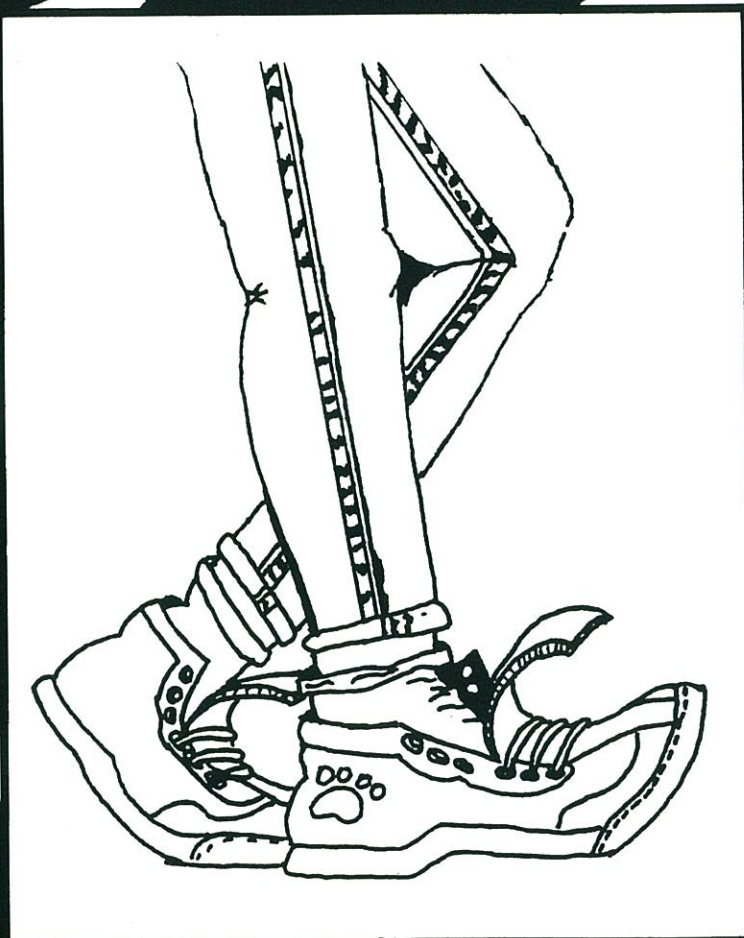


# SPORTS
