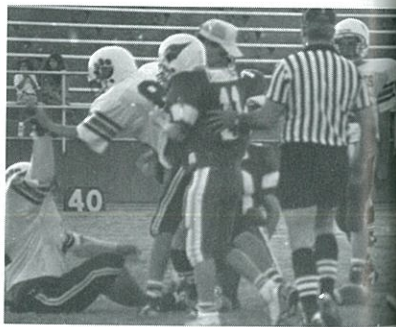
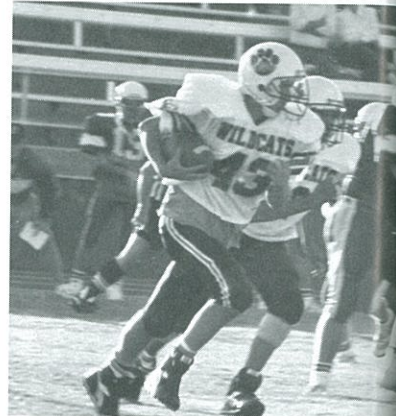
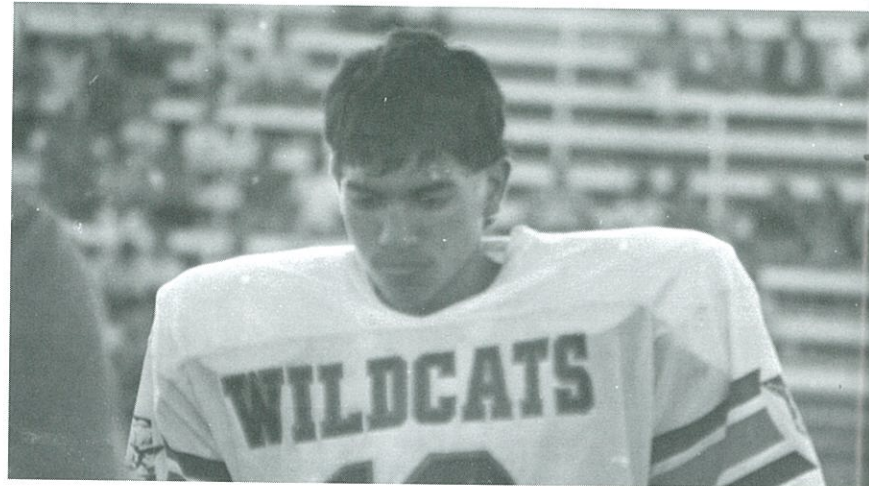


T.E.A.M.

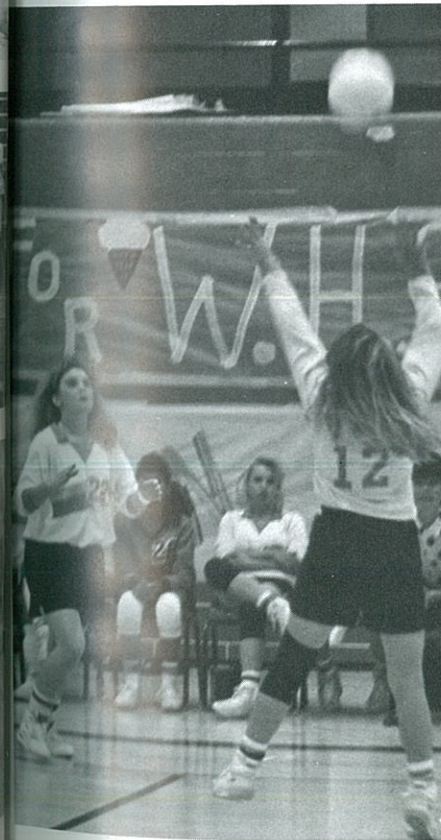
