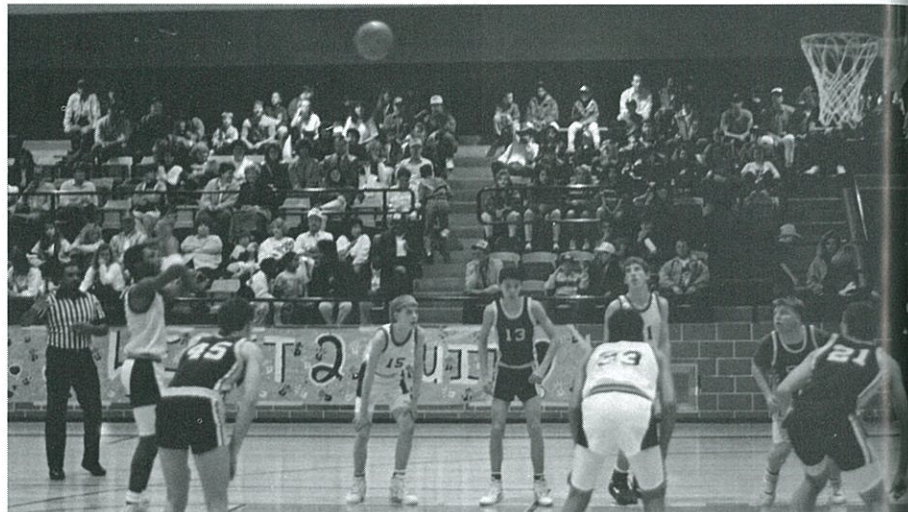
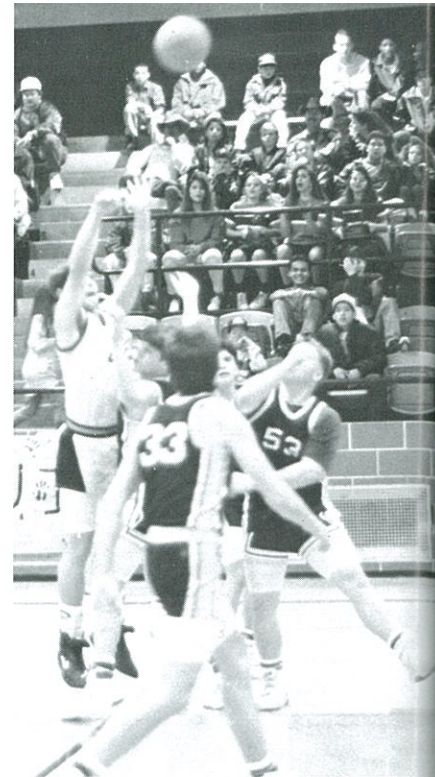
Freshman Shawn Johnson tries for a free throw.

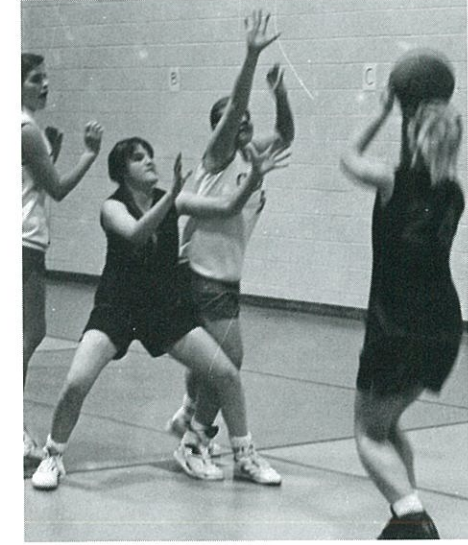
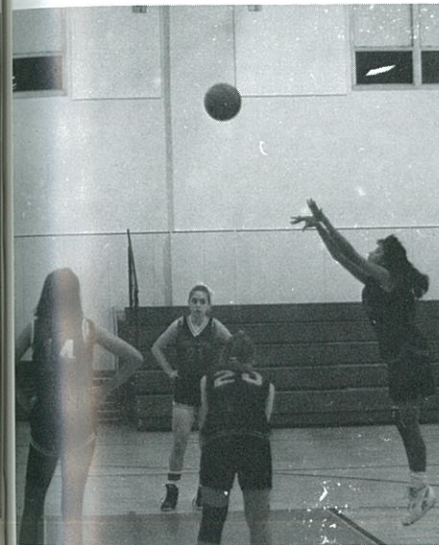
It's The Mikettes!

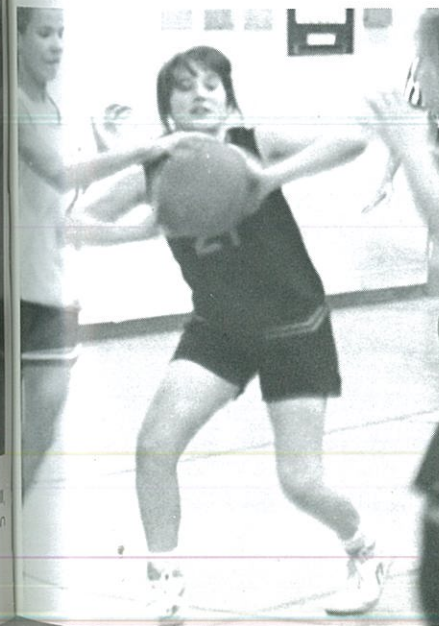


Freshman Shannon Parham blocks while co-captain sophomore Marti Carlton shoots.
