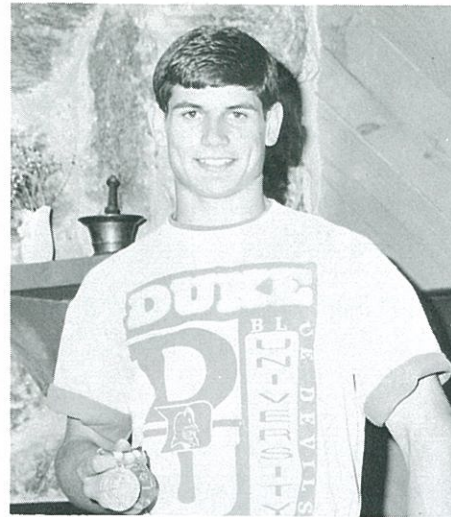
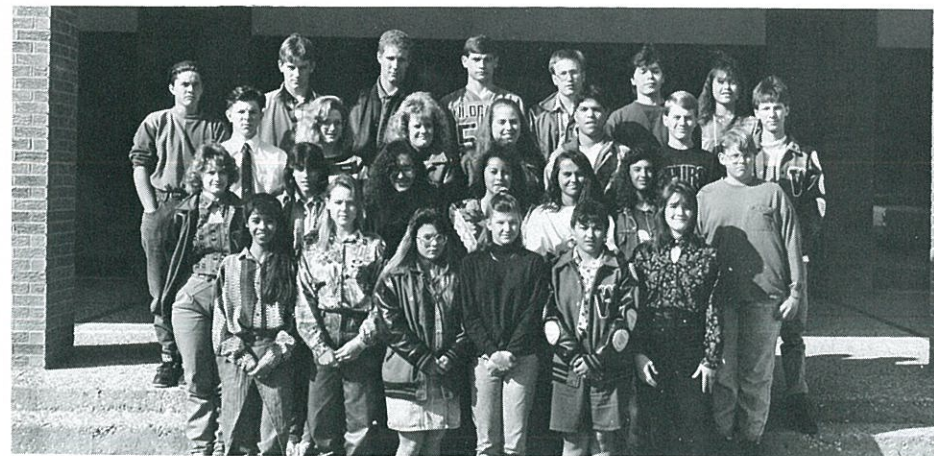
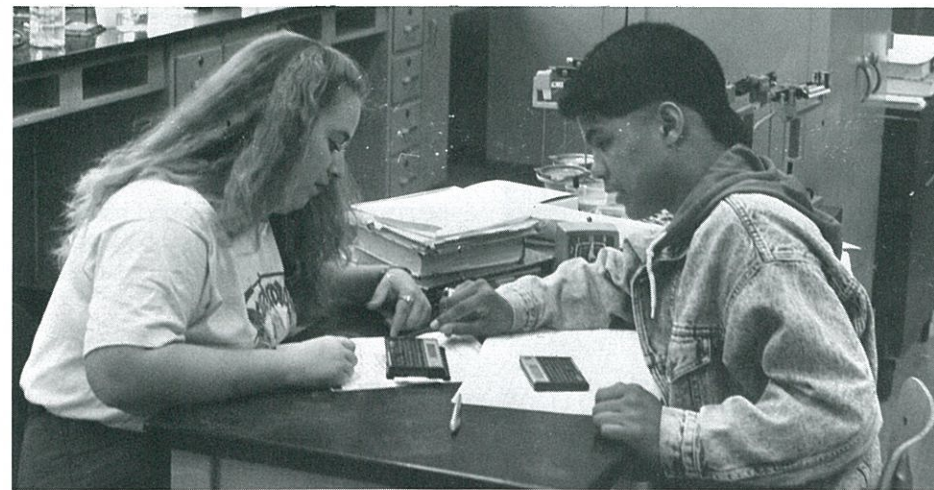


Let's Get Rocked!

Freshman Jeffrey Warts makes a strong impression in high school UIL as he earns a trip to the state meet in number sense and general math.

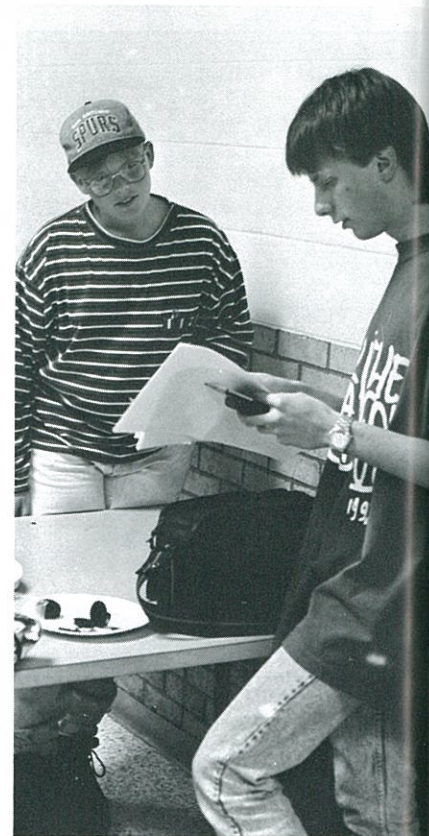

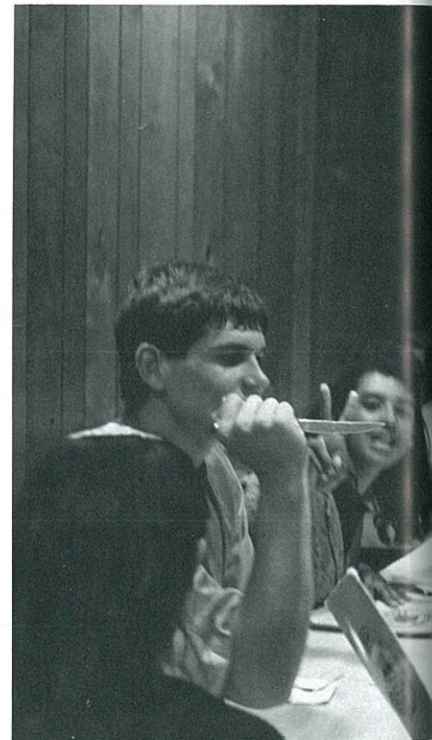


Athletic contests aren't the only events in which WHS excelled.

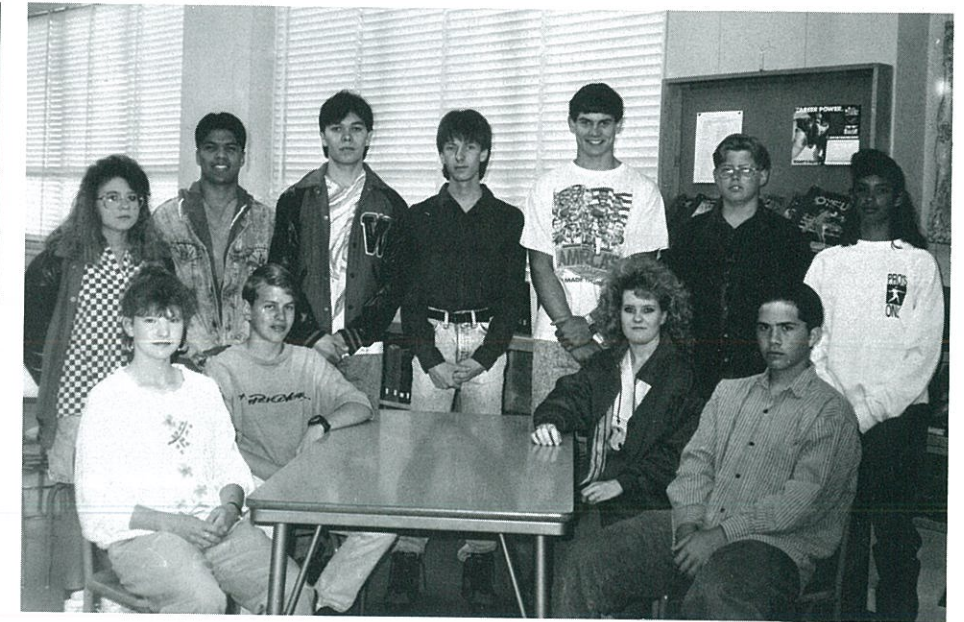
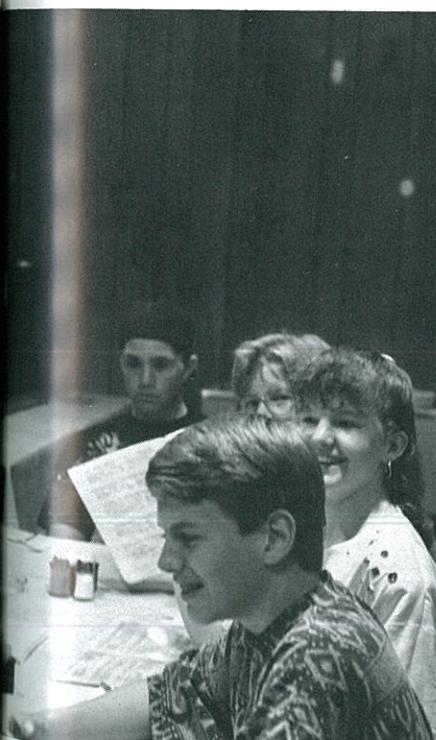
