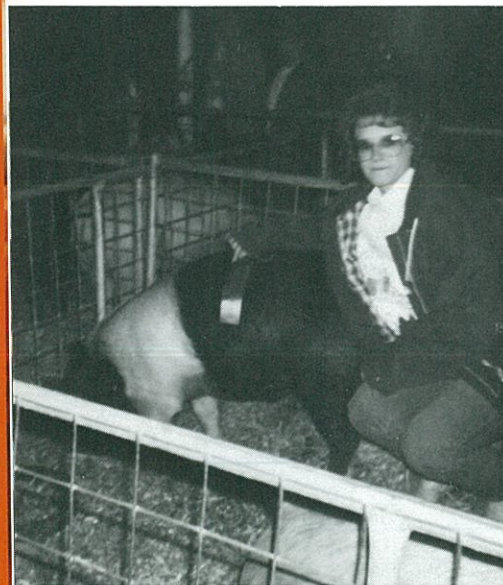
After school and on weekends students always found the time to work and play with their purry, piggy, scaly, straight-haired pets.

According to Twila Akin and her dog Ginger, winter is the time of the year for cuddling.

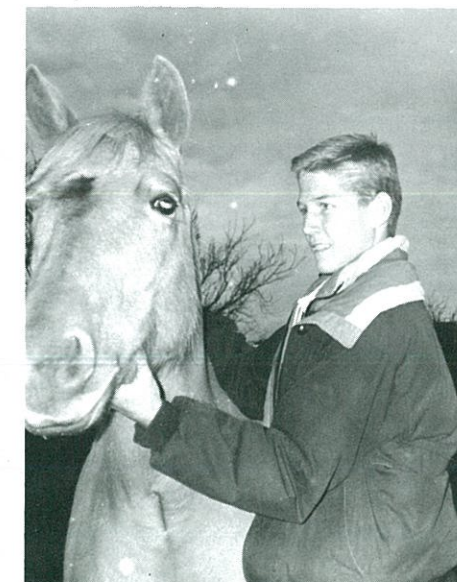
After school sophomore Lucy Valenzuela tends to her baby goat with a little tender, loving care.
