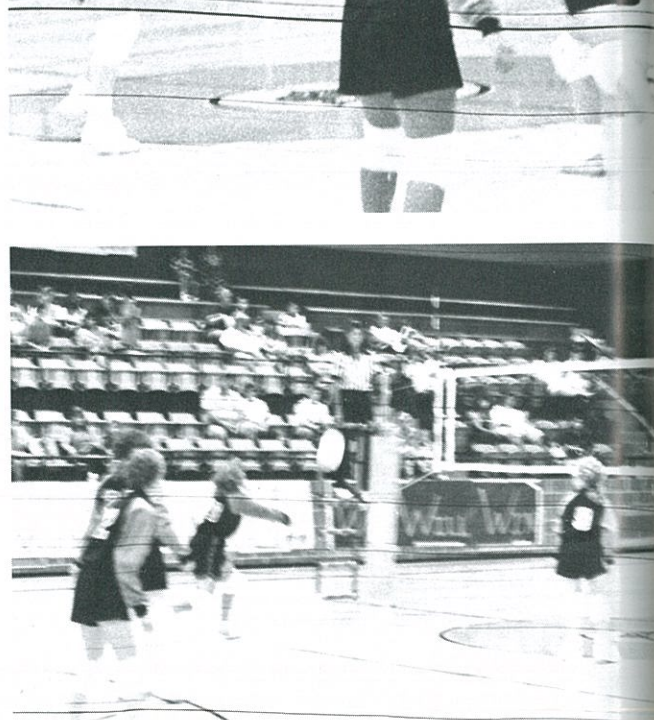
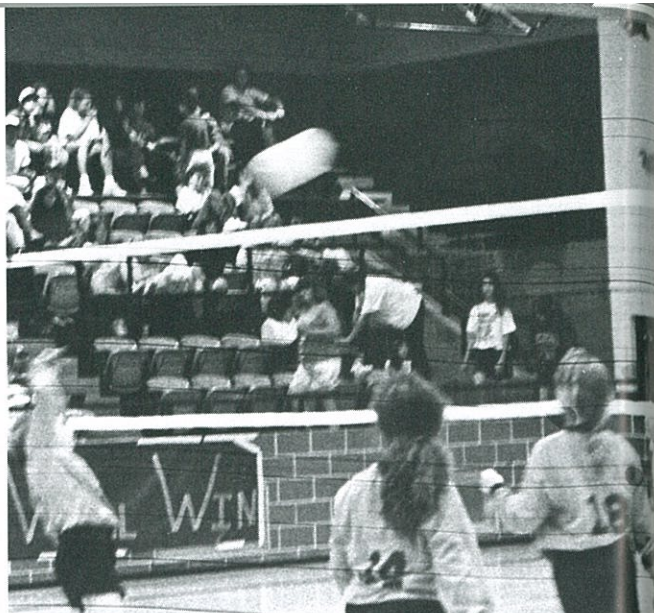


Dianna Ratliff spikes the ball as Amanda Gonzales and Jodi Carlton look on.
