hosted in Wink, for the first time in 28 years.

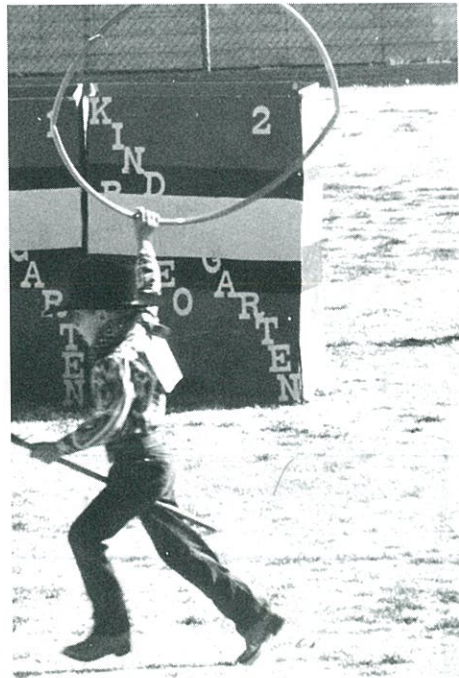
The PeeWee track meet in April allowed the elementary students to show off their running talents.

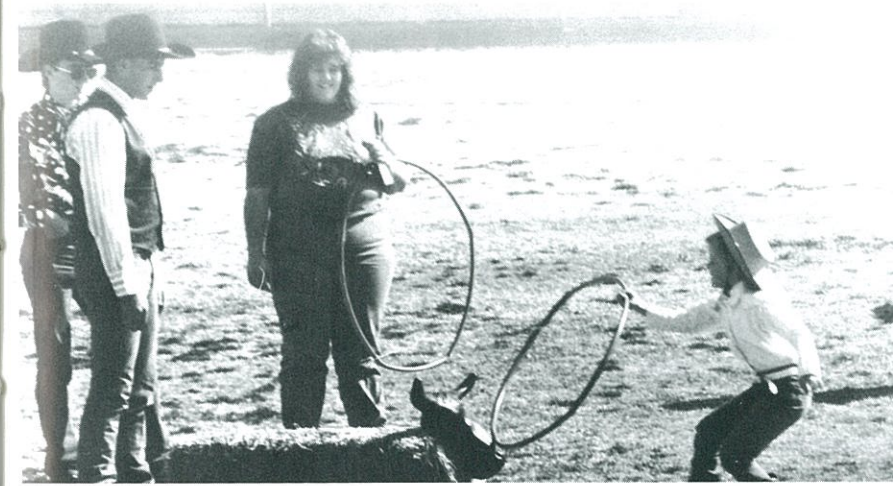

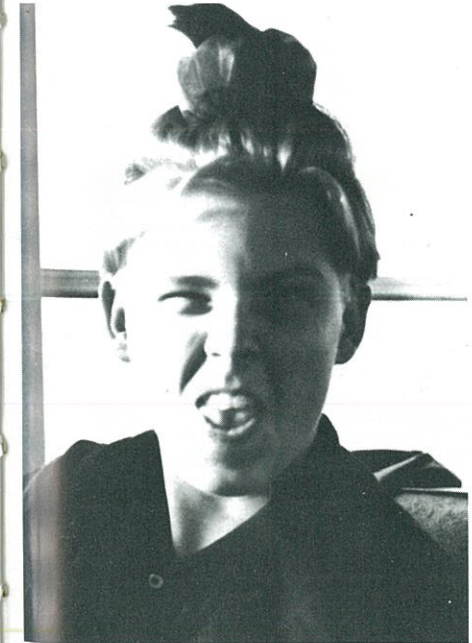
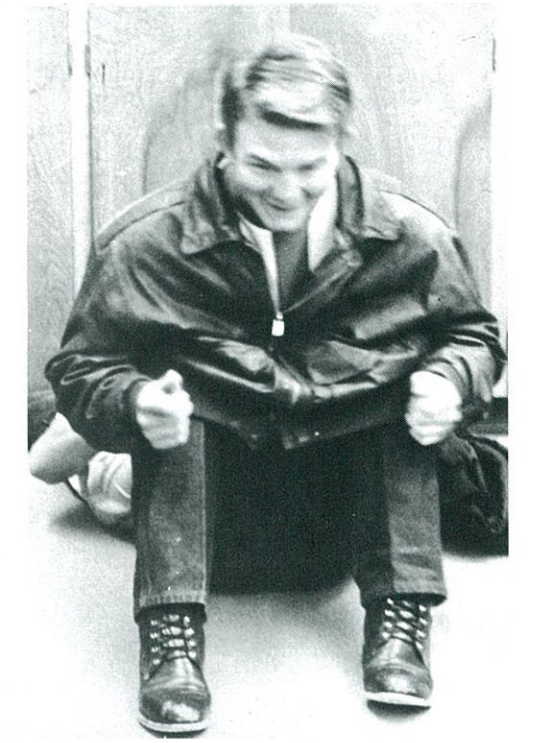
