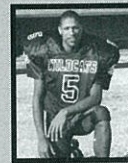

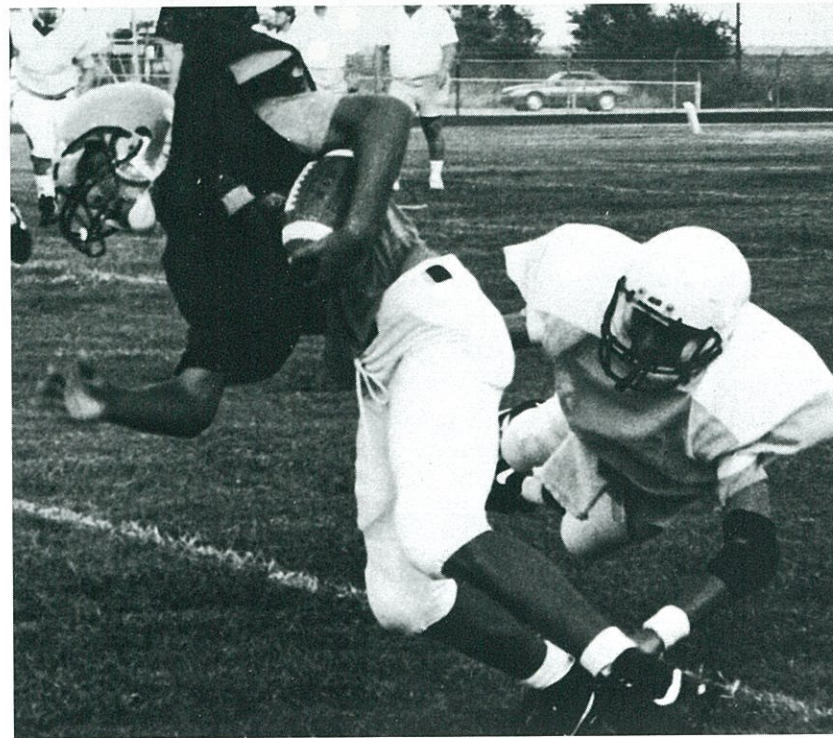

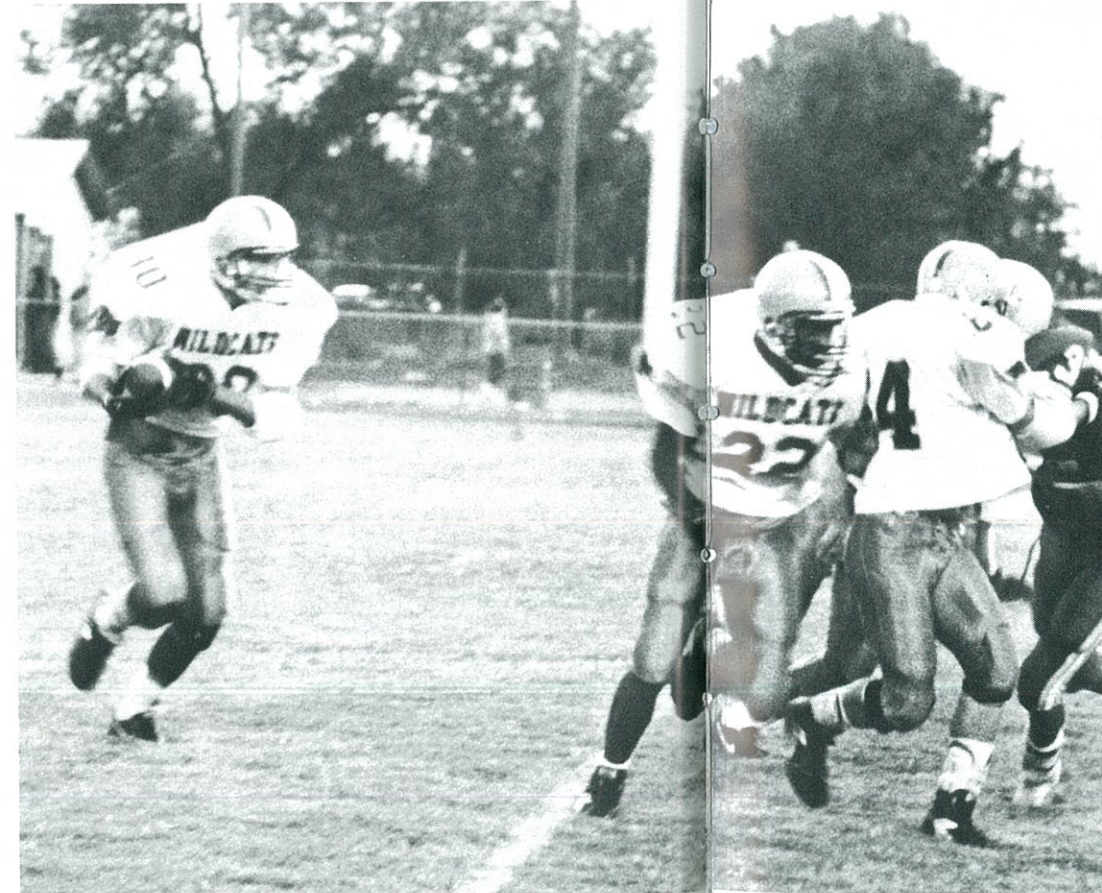
The Cats opened up with a 20-7 loss to McCamey's Badgers, but bounced back for a thrilling 22-16 fourth-quarter comeback

All-state quarterback Shae Scott confers with head coach Sam Scott on the sidelines during a time out.

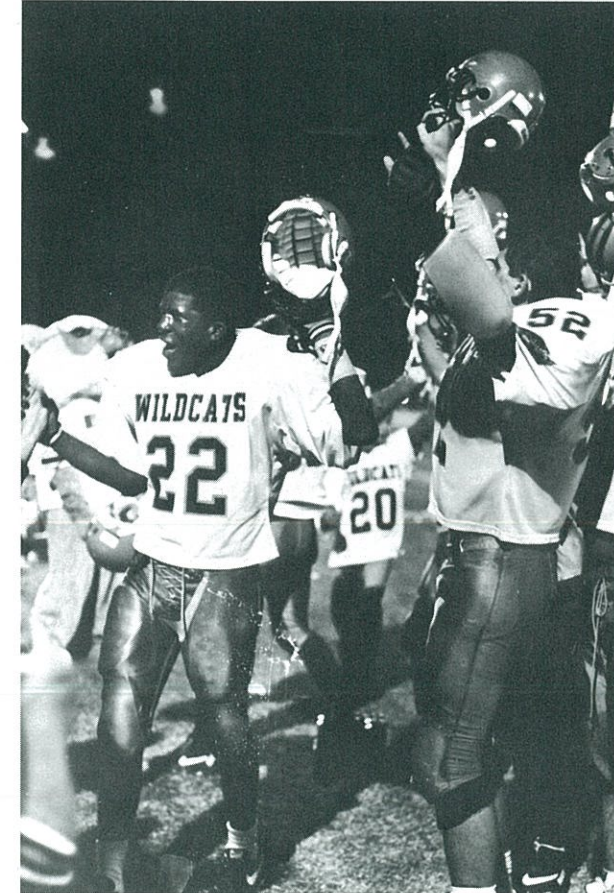
