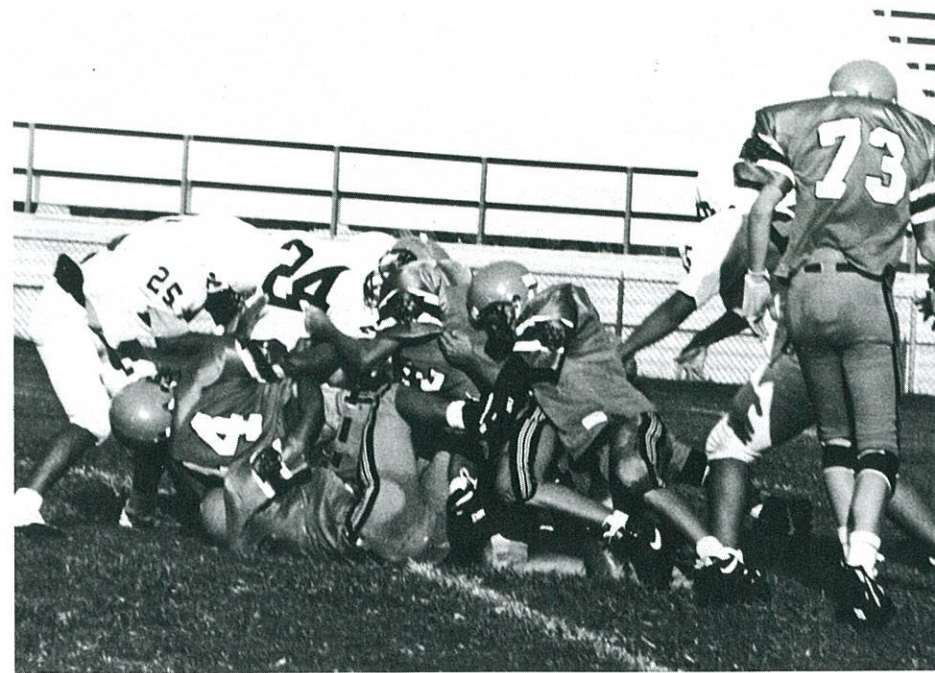
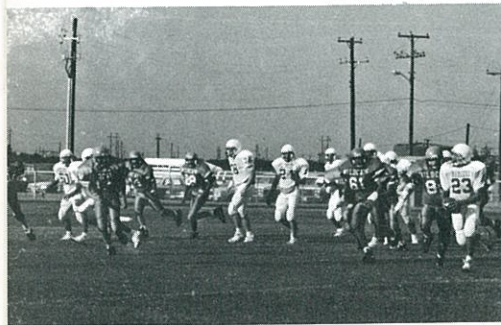


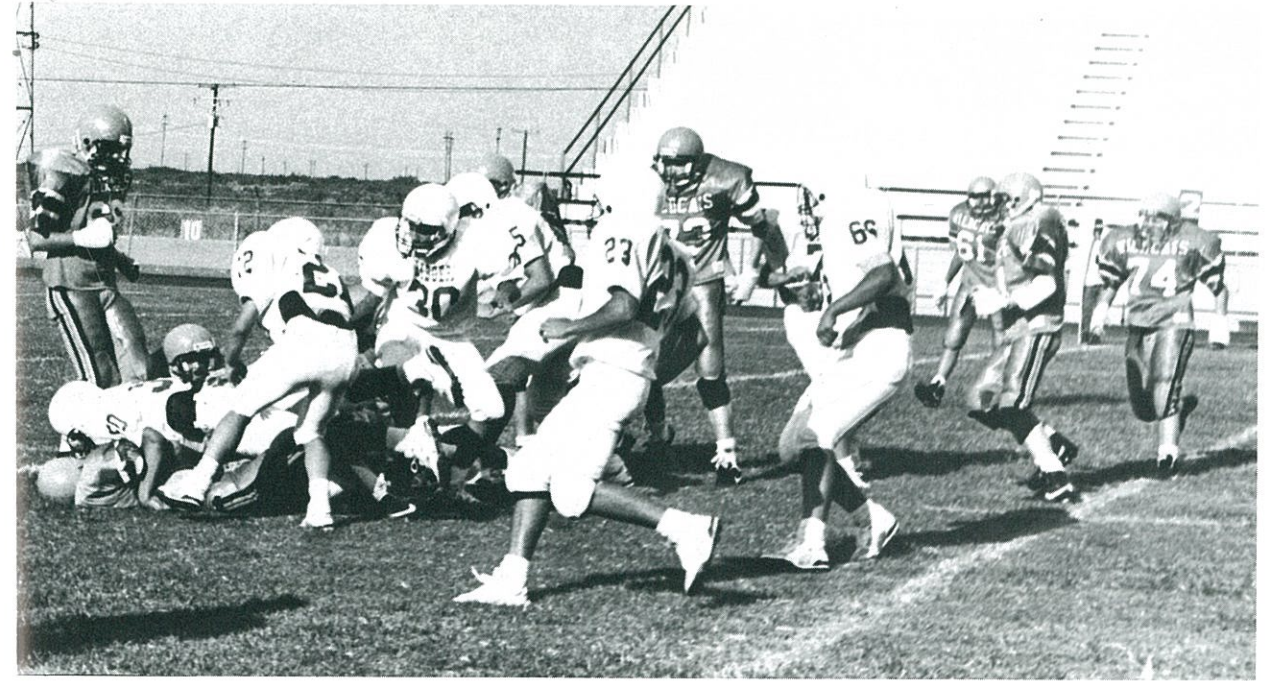
Junior varsity players swarm their opponent's offense, hoping to get a hold of a loose football.

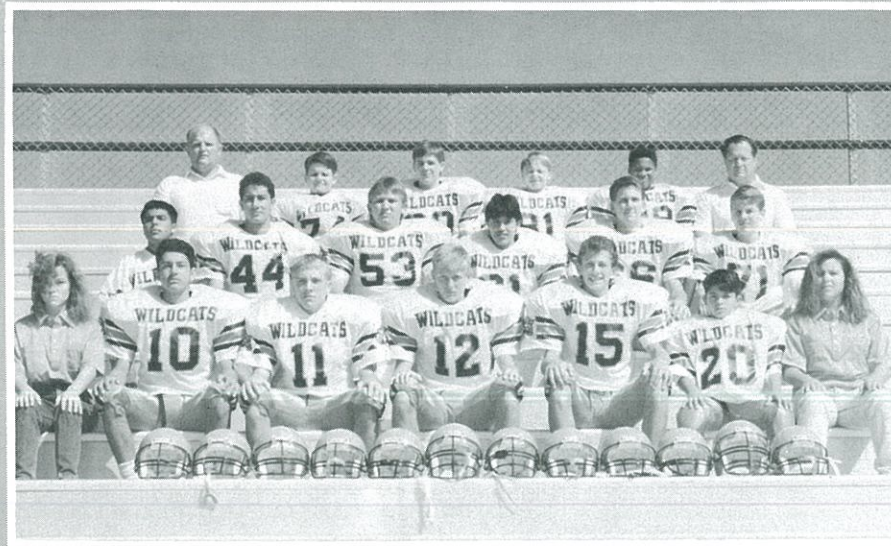


The Wildcats gain some ground against McCamey in the home opener.
