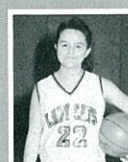

The basketball girls ended a great first season of play with eight wins and twelve losses.

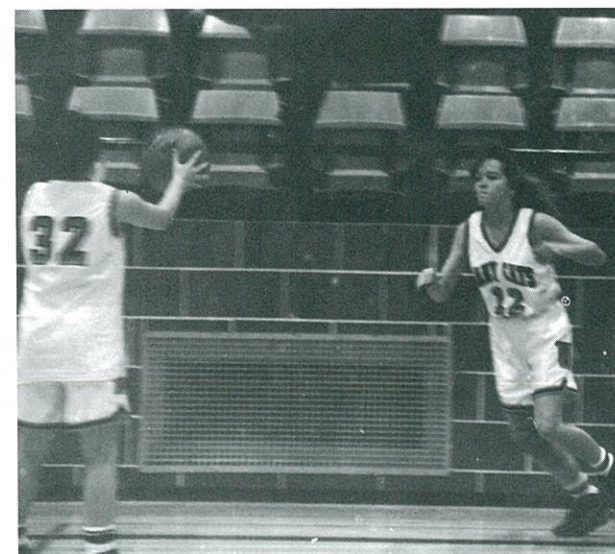

Senior Marcie Sledge passes the ball to freshman Dianna Ratliff.

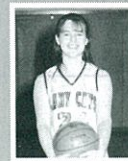

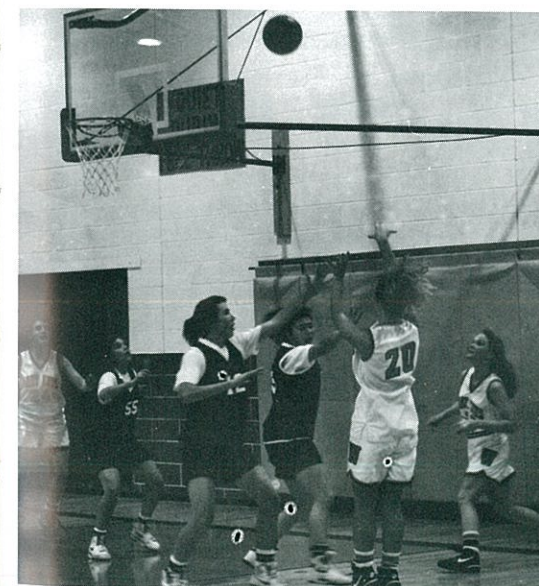

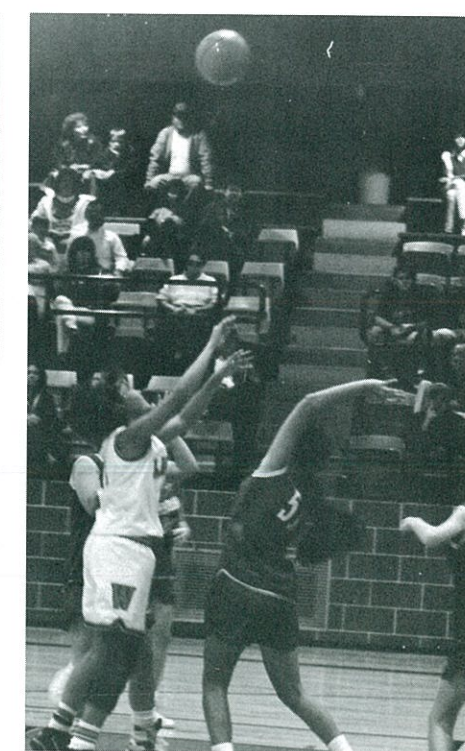
Senior Desiree Moog uses her jumping skills and shoots for two.
