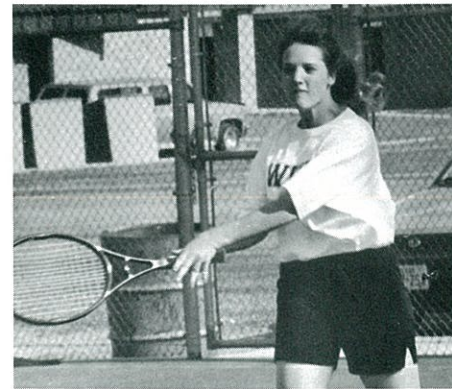


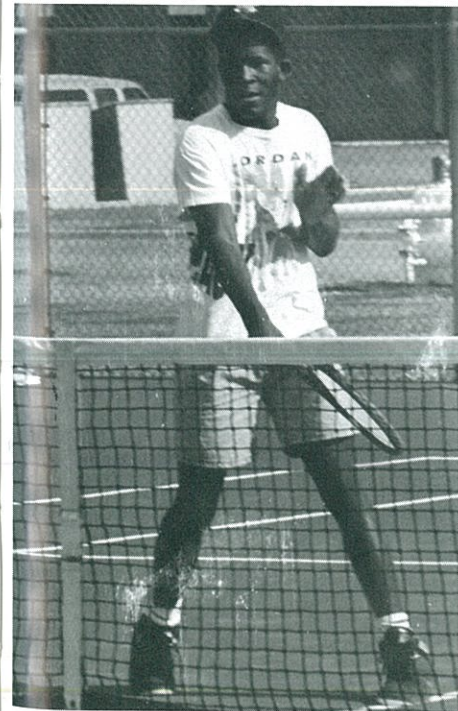
Junior Lucy Valenzuela makes a perfect return during after school practice.
