Homecoming, they decorated the football buses for out-of-town games, and also decided to have special dress-up days throughout the Homecoming week to allow students to get into the school spirit.

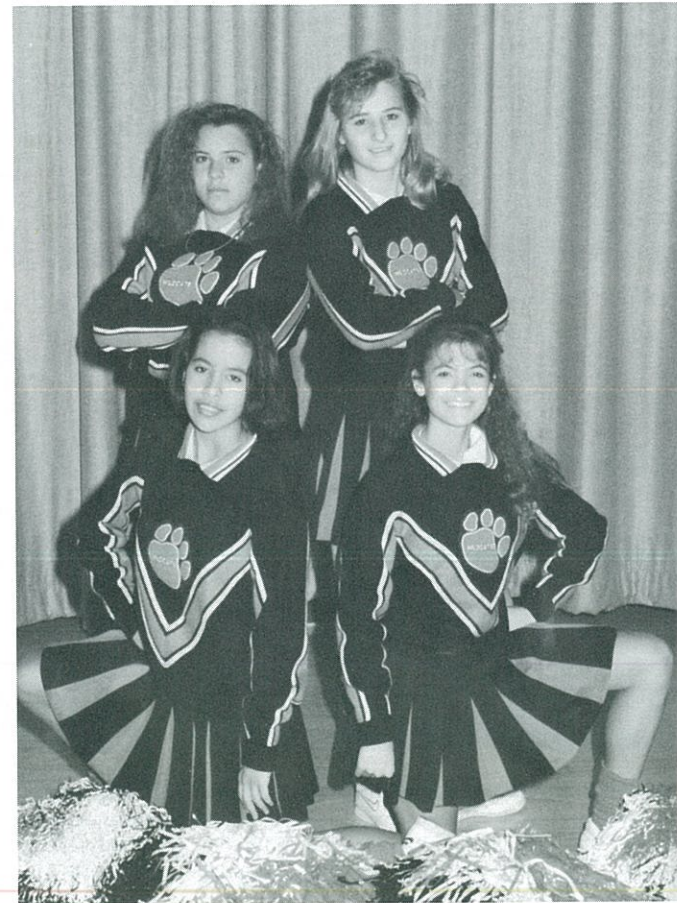
