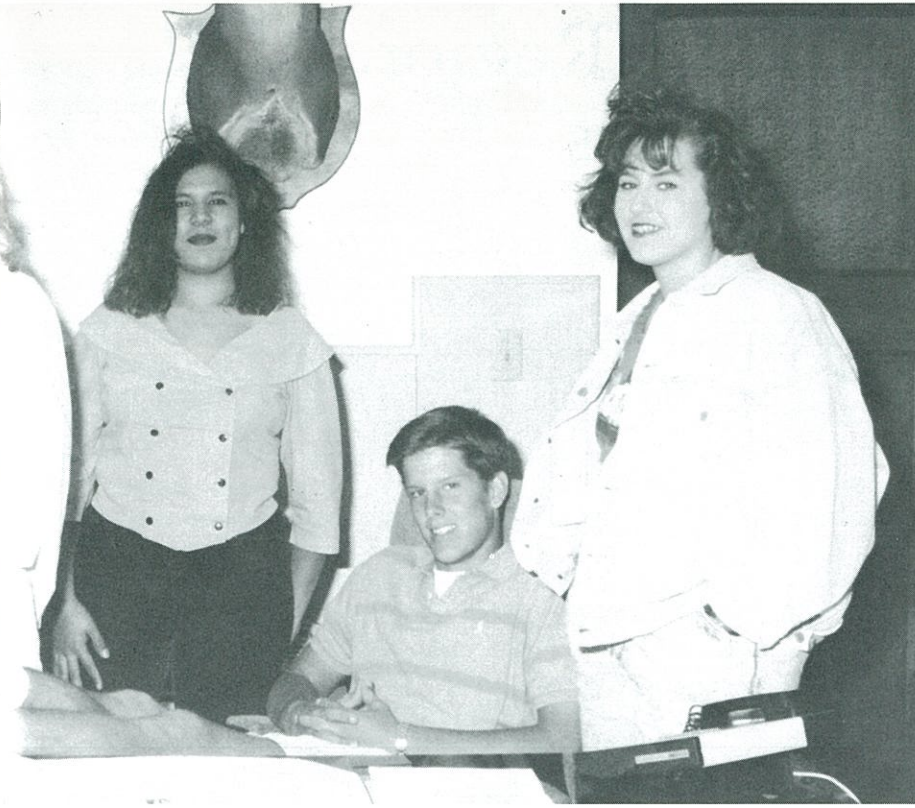
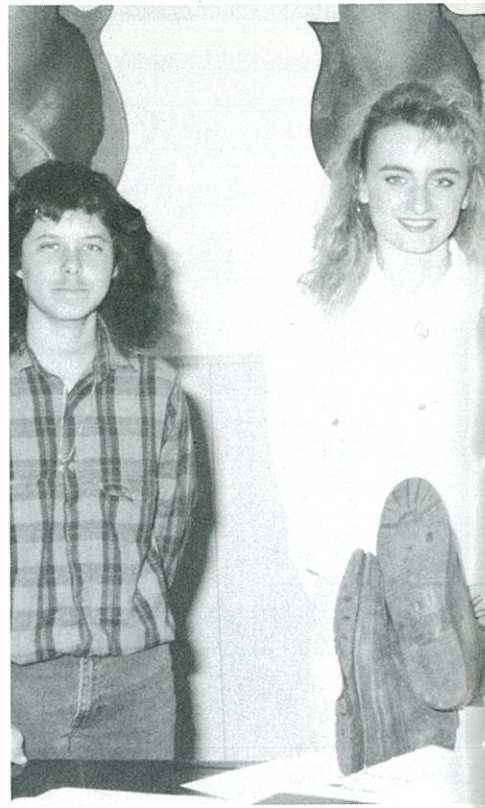
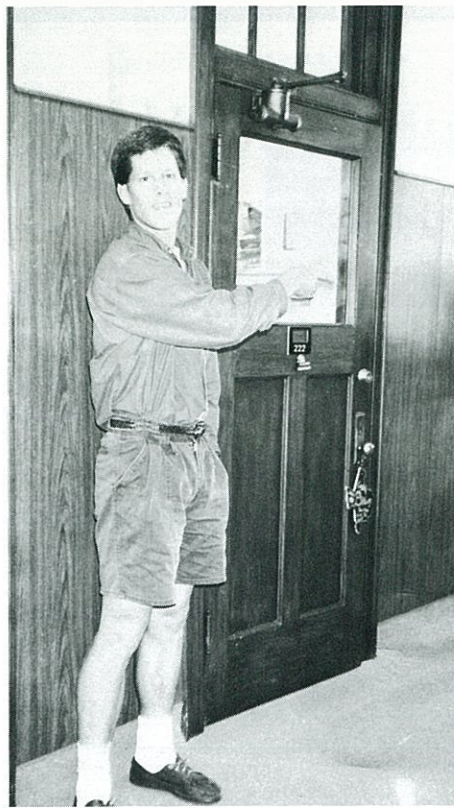


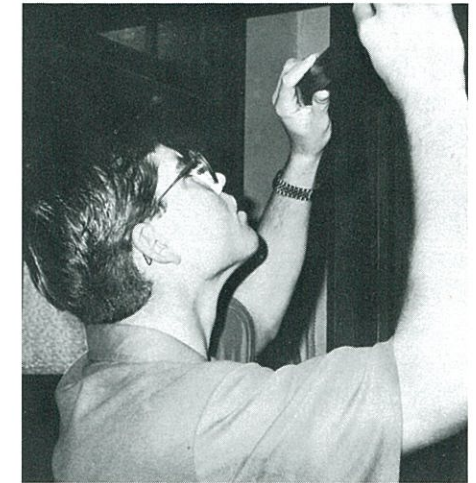
Senior Shae Scott smiles for the camera as he hunts for Coach Brown's absentee slip.
