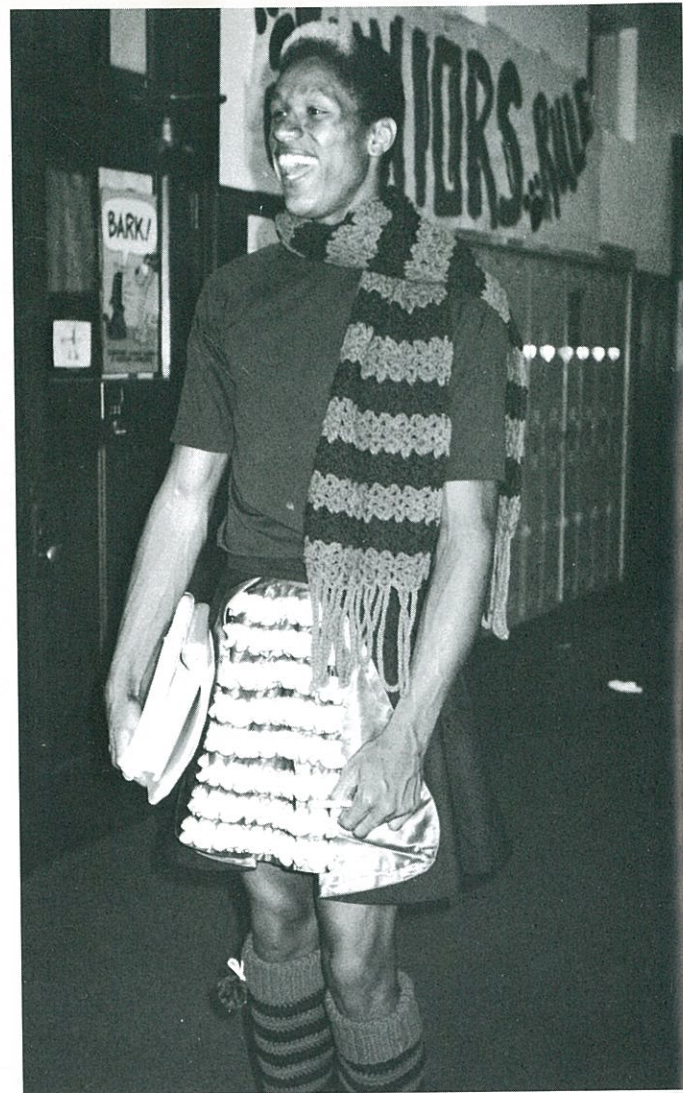


Freshman Jodi Carlton and freshman DeDe Roundtree show their school spirit on 'Crazy' day.

The Cats finished with a 31-14 win over Marfa and the Student Council sponsored a sock hop in the gym after the game.

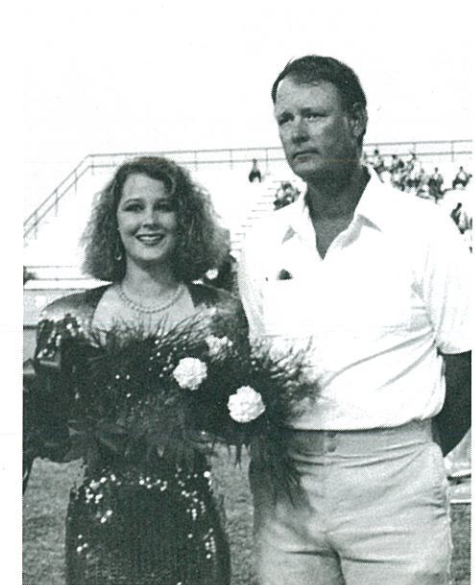
