Charlie takes Miss Kinnian, played by Denise McGuire, out for a date in the park.

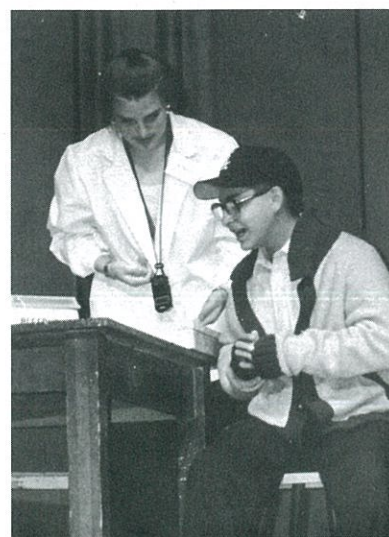
The bag lady, played by Sally Carrillo, and the young lovers, played by David Bickle and Ashley Robertson, set the stage for the scene at the park.



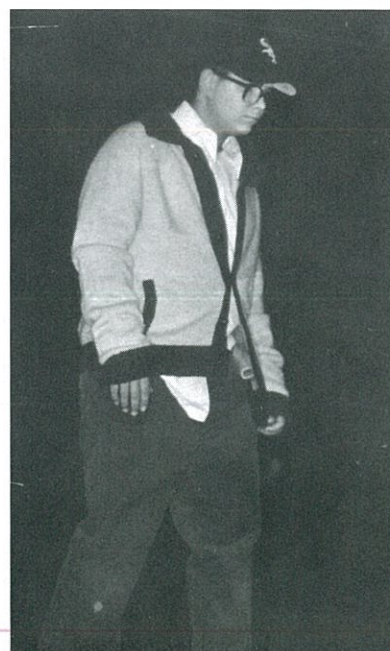

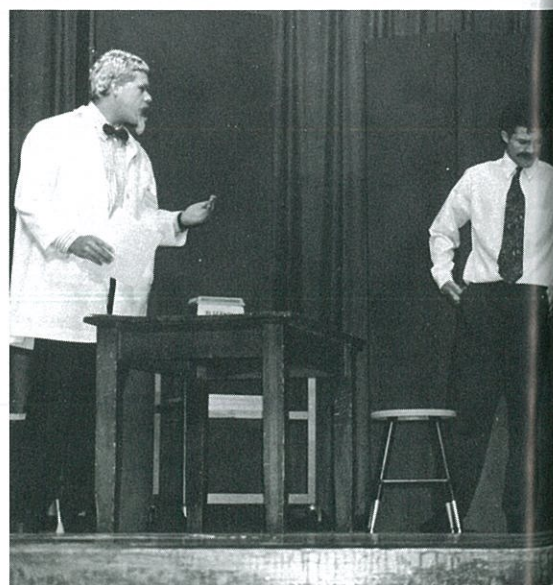

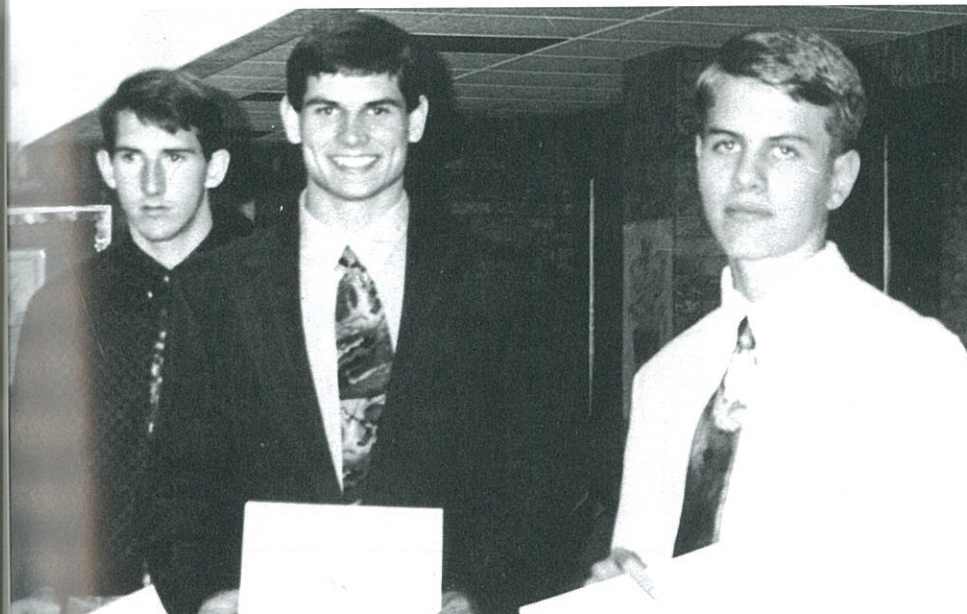


Luke Warbois, as the ghost of Charlie, returns to retrieve his body.
