

# Licensed To Rebound

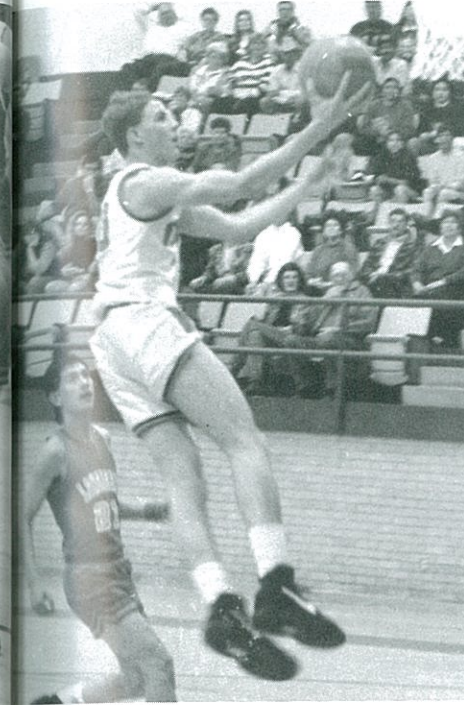

Wayne Gunn is getting ready for an in-bounds ball play against the Longhorns.



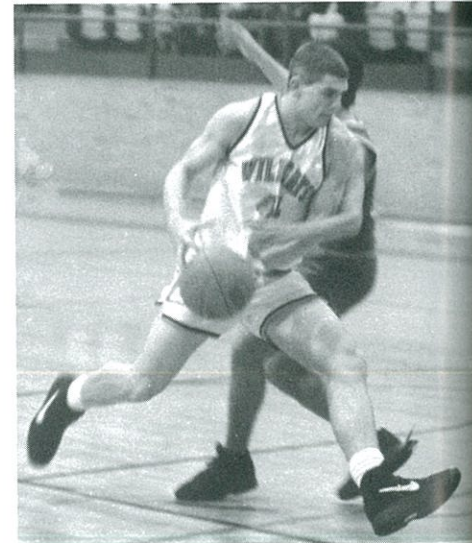
Junior Daniel Gray puts all his energy into a lay-up for a game point.

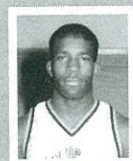

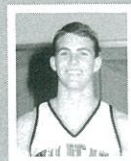
