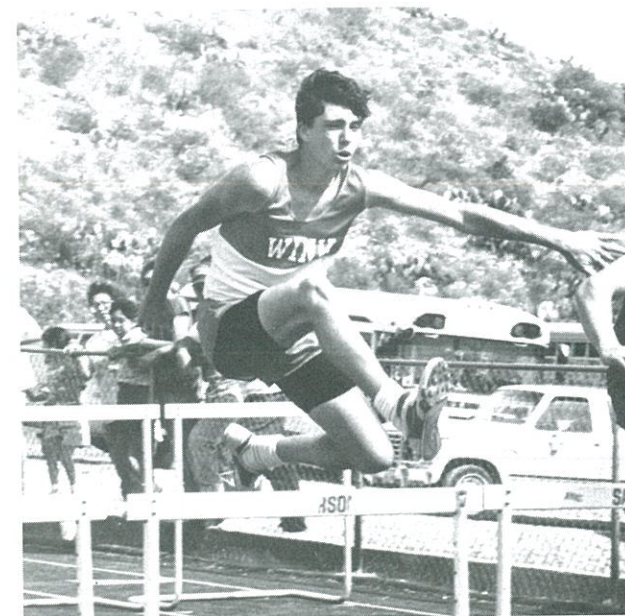
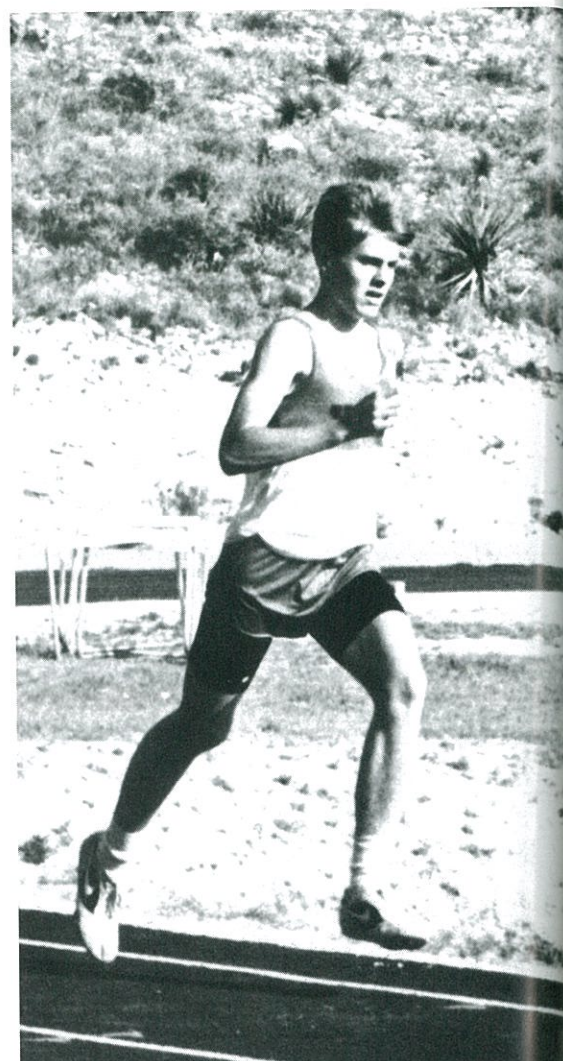
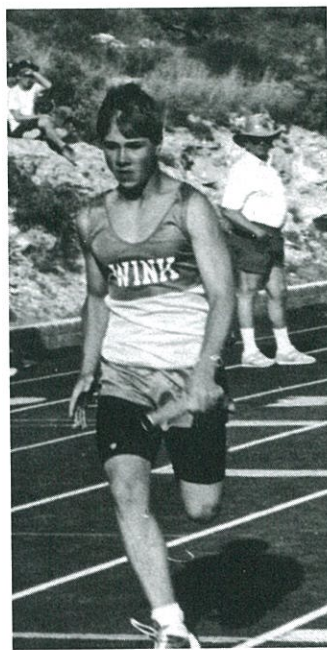


Strong JV Team Holds Promise of Future Success

Brad Scott quickly takes off during the 1600 meter relay race that won second at Sanderson.



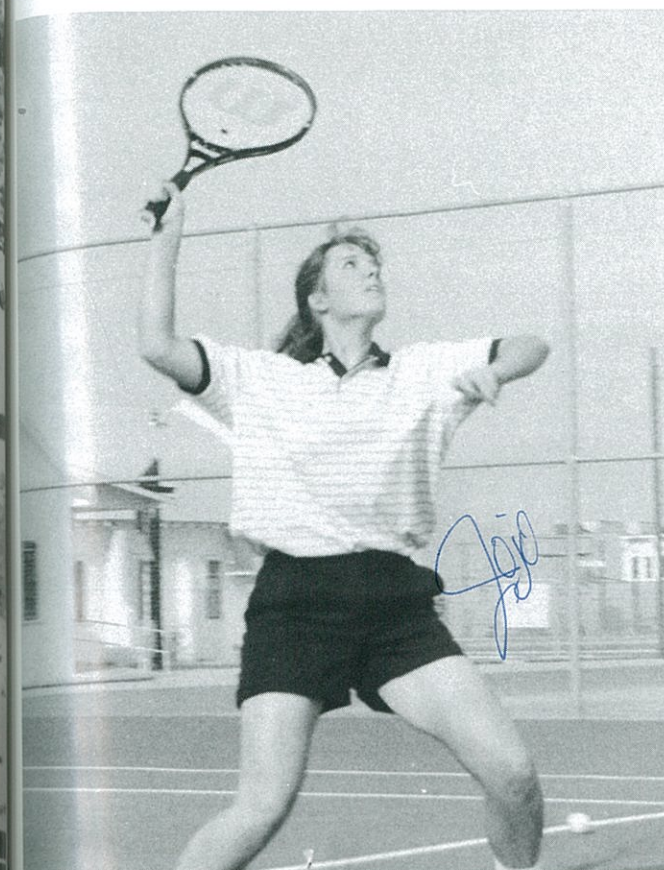

Jodi Carlton's serve led the way for her success at the district tennis meet.

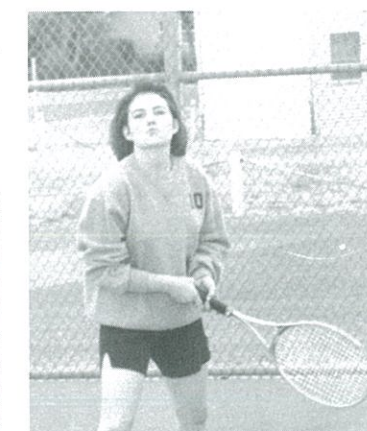
